- 2) The purpose of the hearing is to consider the proposed vacation of a portion of unused and/or unconstructed right-of-way, described as:  
  
INGLIS ROAD, BETWEEN THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S RAIL ROAD  
RIGHT-OF-WAY AND CLATSKANIE SLOUGH AND NEAR CLATSKANIE
- 3) The Board of Commissioners will consider at the hearing whether the proposed vacation is in the public interest.
