

2. The purpose of this hearing is to consider the proposed rate changes for Urinalysis Testing and Transitional Housing at the Department of Community Justice-Adult Division
3. Negative urinalysis decreasing from \$10.00 to \$0.00. Positive instant urinalysis increasing from \$10.00 to \$25.00. Lab tested and confirmed positive results \$25.00 plus an additional lab testing costs. Transitional housing will increase from \$10 per day to \$15 per day.
