COLUMBIA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS BOARD MEETING

MINUTES

April 27, 2011

The Columbia County Board of Commissioners met in scheduled session with Commissioner Anthony Hyde, Commissioner Earl Fisher and Commissioner Henry Heimuller, together with Robin McIntyre, Assistant County Counsel and Jan Greenhalgh, Board Secretary.

Commissioner Hyde called the meeting to order and led the flag salute.

MINUTES:

Commissioner Heimuller moved and Commissioner Fisher seconded to approve the minutes of the April 20, 2011 Board meeting and April 20, 2011 Staff meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

VISITOR COMMENTS:

Jana Mann, 124 Wonderly Drive, St. Helens: She is the WIC Coordinator with Public Health. She wanted the Board to be aware of the program and presented them with a list outlining the services they provide in the different areas throughout the county.

METRO WEST PRESENTATION/PROCLAMATION:

Paul Austin, Senior Paramedic with Metro West Ambulance, came before the Board to present a proclamation for "Emergency Medical Services Week". Metro West has provided ambulance service in Oregon since 1953 and he is personally honored that Columbia County has trusted Metro West to serve this county and looks forward to continuing that relationship. The proclamation before the Board is important to many of the emergency responders in Columbia County. As the providers of pre-hospital care, the EMT's are part of a team of professionals providing emergency health care to the citizens of this county. On behalf of Metro West, Paul invited the Board to attend their EMS Week BBQ on May 13th. At this time, Commissioner Hyde read the proclamation into the record after which Commissioner Heimuller moved and Commissioner Fisher seconded to approve the document proclaiming May 15-21, 2011 as "Emergency Medical Services Week". The motion carried unanimously.

Jan Kenna, CCCCF Director, came before the Board along with Connie Quick representing RSVP and United Way Executive Director Kathy Beck. They are here today, along with

He hosted another Decision Maker meeting last week. This group continues to look at ways to work together to save money and combine services. Some ideas discussed were combining fuel between the agencies and IT services.

He continues to work on public health issues services and moving as rapidly as possible to ensure the continuation of services.

He survived but is now in critical condition at St. Vincent's Hospital. We wish him the best and our prayers are with him and his family.
