The Columbia County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m. in a scheduled staff meeting with Commissioner Joe Corsiglia, Commissioner Rita Bernhard, Commissioner Anthony Hyde, and Janet Wright, Staff Assistant.

Commissioner Corsiglia called the meeting to order.

Discussion was held on the acquisition of the Crown Zellerbach logging road for the Linear Trail. Hancock will give the county an approximate value of the right-of-way to be vacated. That amount can be used as a match.

Commissioner Hyde reported on the Port Westward team meeting held yesterday.

Commissioner Corsiglia reported on the meeting held at the Port of St. Helens yesterday with Paul Langner, Dennie Houle, Janet Wright and himself.

The Board asked Janet Wright to talk to John Knight about the Historical Society meeting and the transportation funding.

Commissioner Corsiglia reported on the Courthouse Security Committee meeting he attended yesterday. The committee members stated there are security concerns and they want to conduct a presentation to the Board.

Commissioner Hyde stated that he spoke with Martin Brandenfels, regarding the bank building that is currently for sale. This building could possibly be used for EOC, instead of searching for a new site and constructing a new building.

With nothing further coming before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.
