Prohibition on Psilocybin Service Centers and  
the Manufacture of Psilocybin Products  
within Unincorporated Columbia County

RESOLUTION NO. 49-2022

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 109, known as the Psilocybin Services Act and codified at ORS Chapter 475A, provides that a county governing body may adopt an ordinance that, subject to voter approval at a statewide general election, prohibits the establishment of psilocybin product manufacturers licensed under ORS 475A.290, as well as psilocybin service centers licensed under ORS 475A.305; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners for Columbia County has adopted Ordinance No. 2022-3, which imposes a temporary prohibition on the establishment of psilocybin product manufacturers licensed under ORS 475A.290, as well as on psilocybin service centers licensed under ORS 475A.305 in the unincorporated area of the Columbia County, subject to voter approval in accordance with ORS 475A.718; and

WHEREAS, the next Oregon statewide general election will take place on November 8, 2022;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COLUMBIA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. REFERRAL. The Board of Commissioners of Columbia County refers Ordinance No. 2022-3 to the November 8, 2022 election which, if approved, imposes a two-year prohibition on the establishment of psilocybin product manufacturers licensed under ORS 475A.290 and psilocybin service centers licensed under ORS 475A.305 in the unincorporated area of the Columbia County. A copy of Ordinance No. 2022-3 is attached hereto as Exhibit 1, and is incorporated herein by reference.
2. BALLOT TITLE AND EXPLANATORY STATEMENT. The ballot title and explanatory statement for Ordinance No. 2022-3, which is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby approved.
3. NOTICE OF BALLOT TITLE AND RIGHT TO APPEAL. Upon receiving the ballot title for Ordinance No. 2022-3, the Columbia County Elections Official shall publish in the next available edition of a newspaper of general circulation in Columbia County the notice of receipt of the ballot title, including notice that an

elector may file a petition for review of the ballot title, as required under applicable law.

4. FILING WITH COUNTY ELECTIONS OFFICE. The ballot title and explanatory statement shall be delivered to the Columbia County Elections Official for inclusion on the ballot for the November 8, 2022 election.
5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
