# COLUMBIA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS BOARD MEETING

#### MINUTES

July 7, 2010

The Columbia County Board of Commissioners met in scheduled session with Commissioner Anthony Hyde, Commissioner Earl Fisher and Commissioner Rita Bernhard, together with Sarah Hanson, County Counsel and Jan Greenhalgh, Board Secretary.

Commissioner Hyde called the meeting to order and led the flag salute.

Commissioner Hyde noted that he will be attending the Economic Development Steering Committee meeting today at 2:00.

Yesterday, he was in Salem meeting with Senator Wyden and Senator Johnson for a grand opening for C-BAR, a company that makes rebar out of composites, not metal and it doesn't rust. This product is made in Oregon and they are considering siting a branch in Columbia County. They also make body armor and containment tanks.

## COMMISSIONER FISHER COMMENTS:

Commissioner Fisher and Hyde met with AOC to discuss various issues, one being efficicies in government. There are state statutes that require the county to be responsible for staffing various commissions and we just don't have the staff to do this. Not all of these committees are very productive and it needs to be determined if they are in fact necessary. It may take a change to the statutes.

Today, item are being moved out of storage and into the museum, with the use of jail inmates. The group continues to work on finding historic photos to site around the courthouse.

He attended the CEPA meeting yesterday at USG. Lorraine Churchhill, our USAI staff person, gave a presentation.

## COMMISSIONER BERNHARD COMMENTS:

Commissioner Bernhard attended the Traffic Safety Committee meeting this morning. Ron Kroop of ODOT is going to be attending the Economic Development Steering Committee meeting this afternoon to look at coordinating transportation with economic development. Discussion was also held on the number of fatalities that have happened recently in Columbia County and the recent fires around St. Helens. It was stated that St. Helens Police has arrested someone in connection with those fires.

She attended the NOHA meeting last Thursday. This was Carol Snell's last meeting and the new director will be starting this month.

The county staff held a retirement party for 3 county employees last week.

She received a call yesterday about the bad mosquito problem this year. Vector control is fogging, but people are encouraged to call them on specific areas of concern.
