WHEREAS, on November 30, 2021, the Lever's filed with the Board a Petition requesting that the Board vacate a portion of The Road crossing on their property; and

WHEREAS, the County Road Official has filed a report, dated August 24th, 2022, attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference. ("Road Official Report"). The Road Official Report recommends approval of the proposed vacation as it would be in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the vacation petition is attached to the Road Official Report as Exhibit 2. Exhibit 2 is incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, Attached to the Road Official Report as Exhibit 2A is a legal description and depiction for the proposed vacation. Exhibit 2A is incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, as shown on Exhibit 2A the Lever's property abuts both sides of the property proposed to be vacated; and

WHEREAS, the Levers have dedicated to the County an additional portion of their property that is sufficient in size to construct a turnaround for the Road; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with ORS 368.351, the Petition contains the acknowledged signatures of owners of 100 percent of the land abutting the property proposed to be vacated and the acknowledged signatures of 100 percent of the owners of property abutting the property proposed to be vacated; and

WHEREAS, because the Petition meets these signature requirements and the County Road Official has found granting the petition to be in the public interest, the Board may make a determination about the vacation without holding a hearing; and

Subject: Road Vacation request for a section of Johns District Road, Clatskanie

Road Official's Report

Marc and Holly Lever have petitioned the Board of County Commissioners to vacate a section of Johns District Road (about 260 feet). See Exhibit 2 that includes all of their submitted Exhibits. Johns District Road is a dead end county maintained road in Clatskanie.

The portion of road proposed to be vacated is outlined in red on the map in Exhibit 2D attached. Mr. and Mrs. Lever own the only property that borders this portion of Johns District Road, shown as Tax Lot 8423-A0-00200.

John District Road has a ROW width of 40 feet. The beginning point for John District Road is the east side of Kallunki Road and travels east approximately 2,050 feet to the Lever property.

Because Mr. and Mrs. Lever own the adjacent property on both sides of the right-of-way, the road vacation request may be approved without a hearing in accordance with ORS 368.351.

By vacating this right-of-way, Mr. and Mrs. Lever will be able to have their newly constructed gate along with the section of public road behind it within their property. They have already worked with the Public Works department to help construct a turnaround to fire department standards in front of their new gate. They have agreed to dedicate the turnaround and portion of road in front of their gate as ROW to allow for the Public Works Department to maintain it.

Request for Comment

The Public Works Department sent out a request for comment on the proposed road vacation and received the following:

Nathan Woodward, County Surveyor:

No comments received.

Deborah Jacob, Land Development Services Senior Planner:

"Land Development Services has no objections to the approval as requested.

The intended vacation of this portion of the John District Road's right of way will not eliminate the subject Primary Agriculture (PA-80) zoned property's existing access to and usable frontage on the remaining right-of-way and will help to preserve the public's safety in this unincorporated area of the county."

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Steve Sharek, Clatskanie Fire District, Fire Chief:

"Clatskanie Fire has no objection to the petition to vacate a portion of the Johns District Road ROW located near Clatskanie. This ROW is located at the end of the road. The applicants would like to vacate the portion of ROW that contains their newly built permitted gate. This is in the hopes of preventing further trespassing on their property.

My only request is that a turnaround is provided at the end of the road prior to reaching the gate to turn around emergency equipment without going through the gate."

Analysis and Recommendation

Every vacation request has distinct circumstances and should be reviewed thoroughly, however, in general, the Public Works Director does not favor vacating pubic rights-of-way as a matter of public interest. Once right-of-way is vacated, it is difficult to reacquire if needed and must follow prescribed processes that ensure fair value is given in compensation for the acquisition.

In this case, the proposed vacation of this portion of Johns District Road would not hinder the development of any other properties in the area. It will not land lock any parcels due to the applicants owning the only property that boarders the ROW.

Mr. and Mrs. Lever went to the board for approval for a gate within the ROW in order to eliminate trespassing on their property for safety purposes. This vacation will allow their gate to become part of their property and in exchange they are dedicating ROW for the newly constructed turnaround. This will allow the Public Works Department to maintain the turnaround and allow the public to use it.

As an alternative, Public Works staff did discuss the option of Mr. and Mrs. Lever having the gate in the ROW without a vacation, however this vacation will eliminate the need to have a gate permit with insurance. It will not affect the Public in a negative way.

I find that there is no compelling need for the right-of-way of this portion of John District Road to remain and support the vacation request.

Therefore, in the interest of the public, I recommend that the request for vacating this section of Johns District Road be approved.




