WHEREAS, ORS 205.242(1) sets forth the days of the week on which the Columbia County Clerk shall receive and certify instruments presented for recording, such days being every day except Saturdays, Sundays and other holidays; and

WHEREAS, ORS 205.242(2) authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to limit the days during which the Clerk shall receive and certify instruments presented for recording, upon adoption of a resolution in which the Board determines that a fiscal emergency exists; and

WHEREAS, during the 2025-2026 budget process, the Board of County Commissioners was forced to implement a furlough schedule due to dwindling resources and increased costs; and

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Courthouse, Courthouse Annex and John Gumm Building and Civic Center will be closed to the public for County business during nine furlough days;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

- 1. A fiscal emergency exists in Columbia County which necessitates modification of the days during which the County Clerk shall receive and certify instruments presented for recording.
- 2. In addition to the days set forth in ORS 205.242(1), the County Clerk shall not receive and certify instruments presented for recording on the following dates:
  - August 29, 2025
- November 26, 2025
- December 26, 2025
- January 2, 2026March 27, 2026
- February 13, 2026April 10, 2026
- May 22, 2026
- June 22, 2026
