WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 368.341(1) the Board of Commissioners for Columbia County, Oregon (hereinafter referred to as the Board) may initiate proceedings to vacate property under ORS 368.326 to 368.366; and

WHEREAS, Robert C. Smith owns property abutting a portion of Fourth Street, and a portion of "D" Street, lying within the plat of Neer City, Oregon, which are proposed to be vacated, and has filed with the Board a petition requesting that the Board vacate said portions of Fourth and "D" Streets; and

WHEREAS, a copy of such petition is attached hereto, labeled Exhibit A, and is incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the petition included a consent form signed by David Welter, owner of additional property abutting the platted but unconstructed rights-of-way proposed to be vacated, but did not include a consent form signed by Gerald L. Modin, owner of property abutting a portion of Fourth Street proposed to be vacated and commonly known as Tax Accounts No. 6212-022-00200 and 1700, nor from the Oregon Department of Transportation, owner of abutting property known as Highway 30; and

WHEREAS, Robert C. Smith has subsequently purchased those properties known as Tax Account Nos. 6212-022-00200 and 1700, from Gerald L. Modin by Quitclaim Deeds recorded in the records of the Columbia County Clerk as Instrument Nos. 03-12528 and 03-12529; and

WHEREAS, Robert Smith amended his petition for vacation by a written request dated August 13, 2003, requesting that the portion of the platted but unconstructed alleyway running from the Columbia River Highway U.S. 30 west to the western lot line of that property commonly known as Tax Account No. 6212-022-00400 be vacated, said amendment being attached hereto as Exhibit B and by this reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Smith further amended his petition in a telephone confirmation that his request for the vacation of Fourth Street should extend to the western lot line of Lot 10, Block 2, property owned by Mr. Smith; and

WHEREAS, the eastern ends of Fourth Street and the alleyway proposed for vacation, as platted, abut the Columbia River Highway 30, and the consent to this vacation from the Oregon Department of Transportation has been received and is attached hereto as Exhibit C and by this referenced incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Smith has requested vacation of these portions of Fourth and "D" Streets and that certain alleyway described above in an attempt to create a property on which a home might be built; and

WHEREAS, that portion of Fourth Street proposed to be vacated is generally described as lying between Lots 10,11 and 12, Block 2 and Lots 1, 2 and 3, Block 5; and Lots 7 through 12, Block 3, and Lots 1 through 6, Block 4, Neer City, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, that portion of "D" Street proposed to be vacated is generally described as lying between Lot 1, Block 8 and Lot 6, Block 9; Lots 1 and 12, Block 5, and Lots 6 and 7, Block 4; and, Lots 1 and 12, Block 2, and Lots 6 and 7, Block 3, Neer City, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, that portion of the alleyway proposed to be vacated is generally described as lying between Lots 2 through 6 and Lots 7 through 12, Block 3, and Lots 1, 2, and 3, Block 2, and Lots 10, 11, 12, Block 2; and

WHEREAS, a map of that portion of the platted but unconstructed rights-of-way proposed to be vacated is attached hereto as Exhibit D and is incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 368.351(2), the proceedings for vacation were initiated by a petition that contains the acknowledged signatures of owners of 100 percent of any private property proposed to be vacated and acknowledged signatures of owners of 100 percent of property abutting the public property proposed to be vacated and the petition indicates such owners' approval of the proposed vacation; and

WHEREAS, the petition submitted by Robert Smith complies with the petition requirements of ORS 368.341(3); and

WHEREAS, because the petition meets the signature requirements of ORS 368.351(2), the Board may make a determination about the vacation without holding a hearing if the county road official, i.e., the Public Works Director, files with the Board a written report that contains an assessment that the vacation is in the public interest;

WHEREAS, the County Roadmaster, Dave Hill, has filed a report dated August 20, 2003, with the Board indicating that it was his assessment that the vacation would be in the best interests of the public and the affected property owners, although requesting that the vacation of "D" Street begin 50 feet north of the Neer City Road right-of-way, retaining this 50 feet as dedicated property for possible future road widening projects, a copy of the Roadmaster's report being attached hereto, labeled Exhibit E and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the petition meets the requirements of ORS 368.341 and contains the acknowledged signatures and owners' approval as required by ORS 368.351(2);

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

 Vacation of certain platted, unconstructed rights-of-way, as more particularly described below and as shown in Exhibit D, is in the public interest.

Tracts of land in Section 12, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, Columbia County, Oregon, more particularly described as

follows:

The following described portions of streets and a certain alleyway lying within the subdivision of Neer City, as recorded in Deed Book H, Page 510, records of Columbia County, Oregon, in Section 12, Township 6 North, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, Columbia County, Oregon:

"D" Street beginning 50 feet north of the Neer City Road right-of-way and extending north to the northern section line.

All that portion of Fourth Street which lies Westerly of the Columbia River Highway U.S. 30, as platted, west to the Westerly lot line of Lot 10, Block 2.

All of the unnamed alleyway running through Bocks 2 and 3 of the above said subdivision lying East of the West lines of Lots 3 and 10 of said Block 2.

- 2. The property described as above and depicted in Exhibit D is hereby vacated and shall hereby vest in the abutting property owners as provided in ORS 368.366(1)(d) by extension of said owners' abutting property boundaries to the centerline of the vacated platted road.
- 3. This vacation is being made with a specific reservation of any existing right-of-way for utility easements.
- 4. Pursuant to Order No. 55-2001, the required fee of \$2,000 was paid by the petitioner, \$1,000 deposited directly into the County Road Fund and \$1,000 into the General Fund, Fees for Services, Road Vacations, Line Item No. 100-00-00-3255, out of which the following costs shall be paid:



RECOMMENDATION: Approve vacations with slight change to proposed "D" Street vacation

Description: Vacations of public streets and alley ways within the Neer City Plat (North East 1/4, North West 1/4, Section 12, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian). The Neer City Plat was recorded in 1883 creating 60' wide north - south and east - west oriented public streets and 20' wide alley ways. The plat was typical for the time, creating rectangle lots and blocks within the plat, without regard to the topography.

The area has small hills of rock outcrops and the east side has a 40' bluff line that runs northwest to southeast parallel to the State Highway. The land is relatively open with a few standing timber as it was clear-cut in 1992 and replanted.

The east end of 4th Street and the east end of the alley way running through blocks 1, 2, & 3, both travel over a 40' bluff and then down a 100 % slope about 100 feet to the Hwy 30 right-of-way, making it practically impossible to construct roads at these locations to County standards. The portion of "D" Street to be vacated separates the private properties of Mr. Smith and Mr. Welter (who has signed in favor of the vacation).

I do not believe the public has any need for the use of these right-of-ways, and it would be beneficial to vacate the right-of-ways so that the property owners may fully utilize the land. I recommend approval of the proposed road vacations with minor modifications as follows:

A. "D" Street. Vacation from 50 feet north of the Neer City Road right-of-way north to the northern section line. (The Road Department desires to retain the first 50' from the Neer City Road right-of-way for possible future road widening projects.)

- B. 4th Street. Vacation from eastern edge of "D" Street east to the Hwy 30 right-of-way.
- C. Alley way dividing blocks 1, 2, and 3. Vacation from center of block 2 east to the Hwy 30 right-of-way.

Assessment: This vacation is in the best interests of the public and affected property owners.

Other information: Consider notifying the Oregon Department of Transportation of this proposed vacation.
