WHEREAS, at the direction of the Board of County Commissioners, the General Services Director engaged in a formal selection process for choosing a firm to design the new Columbia County Transfer Station; and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposal (RFP) was advertised twice in the Daily Journal of Commerce on December 24 and December 30 of 2003, and in the Portland Observer on December 31, 2003, twenty four RFP's were mailed out as a result of the advertising, seven Proposals were received, and the Evaluation Committee read and scored all proposals; and

WHEREAS, SCS Engineering, Shaw Encon, Inc. and URS Corporation were selected for interviews, and the interviews were conducted on February 20, 2004; and

WHEREAS, after conducting the interviews and considering the Proposals the Evaluation Committee unanimously agreed that the Proposal from URS Corporation scored the highest among all of the Proposals;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the contract for design services for the new Columbia County Transfer Station and Household Hazardous Waste Facility is awarded to URS Corporation in an amount not to exceed \$171,100, including all expenses, and the General Services Director is authorized to sign the contract subject to the approval of the Office of County Counsel.
