
WHEREAS, the Request for Proposal (RFP) was advertised in the Daily Journal of Commerce on March 19, 2004, three proposals were received, the Evaluation Committee read and scored all proposals, and all three proposers, Waste Management of Oregon, Inc., Waste Connection, and Allied Waste, were invited for interviews; and

WHEREAS, interviews were conducted on May 7, 2004, after which the Evaluation Committee unanimously agreed that Waste Management of Oregon's proposal scored the highest among the proposals;


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the contract for the operation of the new Columbia County Transfer Station and Household Hazardous Waste Facility is awarded to Waste Management of Oregon, and County staff is directed to negotiate a contract with Waste Management of Oregon and to draft a contract for Board approval.
