WHEREAS, Section 11 of the Columbia County Enforcement Ordinance, Ordinance No. 92-15, allows the Board of County Commissioners to authorize individuals holding certain positions to enforce certain statutes, rules, ordinances, orders and resolutions, and provisions thereof, covered by the Enforcement Ordinance; and
WHEREAS, over the years several changes in positional authority and personnel have been made but have not been incorporated into the enforcement ordinance; and
WHEREAS, an updated comprehensive list of those positions upon which the Board desires to confer enforcement authority, and a reference to the statutes, rules, ordinances, orders and resolutions each respective position shall have authority to enforce, is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and is incorporated herein by this reference; and
WHEREAS, a current list of employees and other personnel currently holding the positions being given enforcement authority is attached hereto as Exhibit B, and is incorporated herein by this reference;
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:
1. Any employee holding a specific position within Columbia County which is listed on the attached Exhibit A, is granted authority and jurisdiction over, and may enforce, those statutes, administrative rules, ordinances, orders and resolutions, and provisions thereof referenced beside the title/position and labeled "Relevant Provisions" on the attached Exhibit A, upon the issuance of a Letter of Authority by the Board of County Commissioners.
2. A Letter of Authority shall be issued to each person holding the specific position being given enforcement authority, as identified in Exhibit B.
3. A Letter of Authority may be issued by the Board of Commissioners upon a change in personnel in any position holding enforcement authority under this Order without further order or resolution.

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4. Order No. 27-2000 is hereby repealed.
