NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Oregon State Building Code and additional related codes are hereby adopted. These codes, and other provisions authorized by ORS Sections 446.185, 447.020(2), 455.525, 455.570, 455.610 to 455.635, 456.915 to 456.950, 460.085, 460.360, 479.730(1) and 480.535 shall have the same force and effect as thought their entire text were fully written or inserted herein. These codes include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1. The 2004 Oregon Structural Specialty Code (OSSC) with Appendices (Based on 2003 IBC).
- 2. The 2004 Oregon Mechanical Code (OMSC) with Appendices (Based on 2003 IMC & 2003 IFGC).
- 3. The 2005 Oregon Plumbing Specialty Code (OPSC) with Appendices (Based on 2003 UPC).
- 4. The 2005 Oregon Residential Code (ORC) with Appendices (Based on 2005 IRC).
- 5. The Oregon Energy Conservation Rules adopted pursuant to ORS 455.525 and ORS 455.560 (Chapter 13 OSC and Chapter 11 ORC).
- 6. The 2002 Oregon Manufactured Dwelling & Park Specialty Code (OMD & PSC) adopted pursuant to ORS 466.062 and applicable Oregon Administrative Rules, Chapter 918.
- 7. The Standards and Specifications for Accessibility by Disabled Persons provided for by ORS 447.210 to 447.280 and applicable Oregon Administrative Rules (OSSC Chapter 11).
- 8. The 2003 IBC Section 114 for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings sponsored by the ICBO.

9. The 2005 Oregon Electrical Specialty Code (Based on 2005 NEC).
