WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 35.610 and ORS 35.235, before the right to acquire such property under ORS 35.605 is exercised, the Board of County Commissioners shall describe the land to be purchased, acquired, entered upon or appropriated, shall describe the purpose for which the land is needed, and shall determine that the appropriation of such land is necessary to protect the full use and enjoyment by the public of the road, street or highway;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. Right-of-way for public road and utility purposes, as described in Attachment 1, which is attached hereto and is incorporated herein by this reference, shall be purchased, acquired, entered upon or appropriated for said project.
- The purpose of the purchase, acquisition, or appropriation of such land is to make road improvements 2. to Mayger-Quincy Road.
- 3. The purchase, acquisition, or appropriation of such land is necessary to protect the full use and enjoyment by the public of the road, street or highway.
