ORDER NO. 16-2006

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 99-01 provides that user fees for animal control services may be established by order or resolution; and

WHEREAS, Columbia County Animal Control is frequently asked to respond to animal control complaints concerning livestock at large; and

WHEREAS, containing and herding livestock back into their proper fenced enclosures takes considerable time and risk to the Animal Control Officer; and

WHEREAS, Animal Control services are provided mainly from fees collected from the licensing of dogs and no fees are collected from livestock; and

WHEREAS, Order No. 60-2000 established at \$75.00 call out fee for after hours call out response by the Animal Control Officer; and

WHEREAS, Columbia County Animal Control Officer is recommending that the after hour call out fee to include calls for services relating to livestock at large.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a call out fee of \$75.00 be established for after hour calls of service relating to livestock at large.
