[2006 Distribution])	ORDER NO. 52 - 2006

WHEREAS, ORS 275.275(1), (3) and (4) and ORS 311.390 govern the distribution of proceeds arising under ORS 275.090 to 275.290 and 275.296 to 275.310, including proceeds from the sale of county lands; and

WHEREAS, ORS 275.275(2), (3) and (4) and ORS 311.390 govern the distribution of proceeds arising under ORS 275.294, including oil and gas rents and royalties; and

WHEREAS, a schedule showing how these proceeds should be distributed, as provided by ORS 275.275 and 311.390, and as provided by the Board of County Commissioners for approved funding requests under ORS 275.275(2)(c), is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 275.275(1)(a)(B), the Columbia County general fund is entitled to reimbursement from the proceeds of the sale of county lands of an amount equal to the penalty and fee described in ORS 312.120 for each property upon which the county has foreclosed a lien for delinquent taxes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 275.275(1)(a)(C), the Columbia County general fund is also entitled to reimbursement from the proceeds of the sale of county lands of the costs and expenses incurred in the maintenance and supervision of county-owned properties and in any action to quiet title; and

WHEREAS, a schedule setting forth the penalty and fee, costs and expenses incurred by Columbia County referred to above is attached hereto as Exhibit B; and

WHEREAS, prior to the 2005 legislative session, ORS 275.275(2)(c), provided that the Columbia County general fund was entitled to reimbursement from the proceeds of oil and gas rents and royalties for the administrative expenses incurred under ORS 275.294 in an amount not to exceed 10 percent of said proceeds in any one year; and

WHEREAS, ORS 275.275(2)(c), further provided that, should administrative expenses incurred by Columbia County exceed 10 percent in any one year, the unpaid administrative expenses may be carried forward into succeeding years until the county is fully reimbursed, although not more than 10 percent of the proceeds in any one year may be used for such reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, ORS 275.275, *Distribution of Proceeds*, was amended by the 2005 legislature, said amendments becoming effective January 1, 2006; and

WHEREAS, ORS 275.275(2)(d) now provides that Columbia County may be reimbursed its actual costs and expenses incurred in proceedings arising under ORS 275.294 for: 1) the maintenance and supervision of a lease or conveyance granting rights to explore, explore, prospect for, mine or remove valuable minerals, oil or gas from the lands, 2) the maintenance and supervision of a lease or

conveyance granting rights to conduct underground storage, as defined in ORS 520.005, and 3) litigation resulting from a lease or conveyance described in subparagraph (A) or (B) of this paragraph; and

WHEREAS, schedules setting forth the administrative expenses incurred by Columbia County under ORS 275.294 referred to above are attached hereto as Exhibits C, D and E;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. That the schedules attached hereto as Exhibits A, B, C, D and E be, and hereby are, approved;
- 2. That the Treasurer is authorized to immediately distribute those amounts set forth in Exhibit "A", Section V, "Distribution to Taxing Districts", to the taxing districts shown therein;
- 3. That the proceeds to be distributed to the Mist-Birkenfeld and Vernonia Rural Fire Protection Districts for impact costs pursuant to ORS 275.275(2)(c), as set forth in Exhibit A, Section I, Oil & Gas Rents/Royalties, shall be distributed only upon approval of an order for such distribution by this Board.
- 4. That administrative expenses incurred by the County which exceed the revenues received under ORS 275.294 as allowed under ORS 275.275(2)(d), as reflected in Exhibit A, Section II, if any, shall be carried over to subsequent years until fully reimbursed.
