ORDER NO. 4 - 2007

WHEREAS, on September 19, 2001, the Board of County Commissioners for Columbia County, Oregon, adopted Ordinance No. 2001-7 which amended the Columbia County Public Road Event Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, one effect of the amendment was to provide that the administrator of the ordinance would be designated by order or resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Emergency Management Director was appointed as the Administrator of the ordinance by Order No. 28 - 2005; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Management Department has neither the time nor staffing available to administer the Public Road Event Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Natural Resources Administrator has the knowledge and experience to administer the ordinance and would be an appropriate person to be appointed as the Administrator of the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that the administrator of the ordinance be appointed by position, instead of by name;



ORDER NO. 3-2007

WHEREAS, ORS 279B.075 authorizes the Board of County Commissioners, acting as the local contract review board, to award a contract for goods or services without competition when it determines in writing that the goods or services, or class of goods or services, are available from only one source; and

WHEREAS, ORS 279B.075(2) provides:

"(2) The determination of a sole source must be based on written findings that may include:

"* * * * *

"(b) That the goods or services required for the exchange of software or data with other public or private agencies are available from only one source;

"* * * * *"; and

WHEREAS, according to the Oregon Department of State Police, Identix is the only manufacturer which makes fingerprinting equipment with the capability of allowing direct electronic submission of fingerprint data to the State Police; and

WHEREAS, the ability to provide direct electronic submission of fingerprint data saves the staff of the Columbia County Sheriff's Office a great amount of time and paperwork, and which is not available from other vendors;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the equipment required for the exchange of fingerprint data with the Department of State Police are available from only one source, and determines that Identix is the sole source of such fingerprinting equipment.
