WHEREAS, on February 22, 2007, Matt Isaacson submitted an application to name a private road to accommodate emergency response for the existing and proposed dwellings accessed by that road; and

WHEREAS, the application included a complete listing of all owners of affected properties and the signatures of those property owners; and

WHEREAS, the applicant requests the name to be Benson Heights Drive, Beaver Valley Heights, or Paulson Heights, in order of preference; and

WHEREAS, the Land Development Services Department mailed a Referral & Acknowledgment to Columbia 911, the County Roadmaster, the Clatskanie RFPD, and the Clatskanie Post Office requesting input as to the suggested road names; and

WHEREAS, no agency has any objection to the naming of the private road and both Columbia 911 and the County Roadmaster recommend Benson Heights Drive as the road name; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 81-6, as amended, the Board may rename a road after receiving a petition signed by the majority of the citizens living on the road; and

WHEREAS, two parties currently live on the private road, who are also owners of the respective properties.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered as follows:

- 1. The private road shall be named "Benson Heights Drive".
- 2. The applicant shall be responsible for purchase and installation of the road name signs, posts and other necessary hardware from the County Road Department to be installed in suitable locations before the final inspection of the dwelling under Building Permit BLD 2007-00302 (or) prior to the issuance for another Building Permit for a dwelling accessed by said private road, whichever comes first.
