## PARCEL 1 – Permanent Easement for Slopes, Overhead Power and Communication Service Lines, Fixtures and Facilities

A parcel of land lying in the Northwest one-quarter of Section 6, Township 3 North, Range 1 West, W.M. Columbia County, Oregon and being a portion of that property described in that Statutory Warranty Deed to North Creek Recycling LLC, recorded March 15, 2006, Fee No. 2006-003489, Columbia County Clerk's Office; the said parcel being that portion of said property included in a strip of land variable in width, lying on the Northwesterly side of relocated Honeyman Road, which center line is described as follows:


