Awarding a Public Contract for Emergency) ORDER NO. 2-2008
Construction and Repair Work)

WHEREAS, heavy rain and flooding occurred throughout Columbia County in early December, 2007, and as a result significant damage occurred to Colvin Road and Palm Hill Road (collectively, "the Roads") at several locations near the City of Clatskanie; and

WHEREAS, the damage has made the Roads unsafe for passenger vehicles and not passable in areas, necessitating the excavation and removal of soil, vegetation and slide debris from the Roads and related ditches, channels, and slopes, as directed by the Public Works Director; and

WHEREAS, there are no feasible detours; and

WHEREAS, ORS 279C.335(6) and OAR 137-049-0150 exempt an emergency contract for the repair of roads from the public contracting procedures upon a declaration that Emergency circumstances exist that require prompt execution of a Public Contract for emergency construction or repair work; and

WHEREAS, the declaration shall exempt the contract from the public bidding requirements of ORS 279C.335(1); and

WHEREAS, the declaration may also waive the requirement of furnishing a performance bond and payment bond for the emergency contract;

WHEREAS, an emergency contract was previously awarded to Kynsi Construction via Order 153-2007, however Kynsi Construction is unable to perform all of the work at this time, necessitating an additional contract for the additional emergency work that Kynsi Construction is unable to perform;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Emergency circumstances exist on Colvin Road and Palm Hill Road at various locations near the City of Clatskanie that require prompt execution of a Public Contract for emergency construction or repair work.


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
2. The Public Contract shall be limited to construction and repairs on Colvin Road and Palm Hill Road, including the excavation and removal of soil, vegetation and slide debris from the Roads, ditches, channels, and slopes at various locations, as directed by the Public Works Director, and accessory work as deemed necessary by the Public Works Director.
3. No performance bond or payment bond shall be required in the Public Improvement Contract.
4. The new Public Improvement Contract shall be awarded to TFT Construction.
