WHEREAS, in December of 2007, portions of Columbia County were devastated by major Pacific storms; and

WHEREAS, flooding caused significant damage to homes and businesses in the City of Vernonia and in unincorporated areas of Columbia County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vernonia and Columbia County have agreed to make a joint application for Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Funds to reconstruct or remove damaged buildings, which will be administered by Columbia County, likely through a contract administrator; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vernonia and Columbia County have agreed to certain maximum levels of funding per building, and desire to have such maximum levels be applied by the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The County hereby adopts the following maximum levels of funding for Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds received for the 2007 flood event:
 - A. Single-family owner occupied residential houses to be elevated- \$35,000;
 - B. Single-family owner occupied houses to be purchased- \$90,000;
 - C. Small commercial building projects to be purchased- \$150,000.
2. The County shall apply Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds received from the Oregon Office of Emergency Management according to the above maximum levels within the City of Vernonia as well as within unincorporated Columbia County.
