NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners for Columbia County, Oregon will hold a public auction for the leasing of certain underground gas storage rights situated in Columbia County, Oregon.

Competitive oral bidding will be held at the Columbia County Courthouse, Room 308, 230 Strand, St. Helens, Oregon, beginning at 10:30 a.m. on Thursday, March 26, 2009, pursuant to the leasing rules adopted by the Board. The auction will be for the parcels described below, which shall be offered as one group. The Board of Commissioners reserves the right to withdraw the group from bidding and to reject any or all bids upon a finding that it is in the public interest to do so.

The minimum acceptable bonus bid is Forty Dollars US (\$40.00) per acre. The primary lease term is forty (40) years from the Effective Date of the Lease for the Adams Storage Area. The royalty on economically recoverable native oil and gas, whether or not produced, is 20 percent of actual proceeds received from the sale of such oil or gas, calculated at the well less certain costs described in the lease document. In addition, a bonus of 10 percent shall be added to the amount of royalty to compensate for the potential future use of any Native Oil or Gas in the same Pool which is not Economically Recoverable. The annual rental is Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per acre per year adjusted on an annual basis according to a formula described in the lease document.

Immediately following the auction, the highest bidder for each parcel shall pay bid security in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bonus bid per acre plus ten percent (10%) of the first year's rental per acre times the total number of acres in the parcel, plus recording and handling fees of \$45.00, and sign such forms as may be required by the Board. No later than Monday, March 30, 2009, at 5:00 p.m. (PDT), the highest bidder for each parcel or group of parcels shall pay the balance of the bonus bid plus the first year's rental for the parcel. Upon compliance, the highest bidder for each parcel or group of parcels shall be awarded a lease.
