WHEREAS, on November 3, 2004, *nunc pro tunc* October 29, 2004, the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Columbia entered of record the General Judgment in *Columbia County v. Carter, F.F. & Grace L., et al.*, Case No. 04-2352; and

WHEREAS, on November 8, 2006, pursuant to that General Judgment, Columbia County, a political subdivision of the state of Oregon, acquired certain foreclosed real property through deed recorded in the deed records of the Columbia County Clerk as Instrument No. 2006-014613, including a certain parcel of land situated in the City of Rainier which was formerly owned by Todd Marchant; and

WHEREAS, this property is referred to as Tax Map ID No. 7N2W16-DC-05700 and Tax Account No. 18321and is more particularly described as:

Block J, Roxy Park, Columbia County, Oregon;

and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners deemed this property surplus to the County's needs, that the highest and best use would be to an adjoining property owner, and directed that letters be sent to the adjoining property owner(s) advising that the property would be placed for sale; and

WHEREAS, Paul R. and Barbara Horton, adjacent property owners, submitted an offer to the County to purchase this parcel; and

WHEREAS, on February 23, 2009, Paul R. and Barbara Horton submitted a check to Columbia County in the amount of \$545, the sum of \$500 to purchase this parcel and the sum of \$45 to cover recording and handling fees; and

WHEREAS, ORS 275.225 permits the County to sell county land by private sale, provided that the property is assessed at less than \$15,000 on the most recent assessment roll prepared for the County, and is unsuited for construction or placement of a dwelling under current zoning ordinances and building codes of the County; and

WHEREAS, the property has been assessed at \$420, and is unsuited for construction or placement of a dwelling; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 275.225, notice of private sale was published in a newspaper of general circulation on April 1, 2009, and more than 15 days has elapsed since publication of said notice; and

WHEREAS, no further offers have been received by the County pursuant to this notice;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to ORS 275.225, the Board finds this to be a reasonable offer for this property and hereby authorizes the sale of the above-described property to Paul R. and Barbara Horton for \$500.
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners shall execute the Quitclaim Deed for Tax Map ID No. 7N2W16-DC-05700 and Tax Account No. 18321 to Paul R. and Barbara Horton, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and by this reference incorporated herein, for the sum of \$500, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

All rights to any minerals, mineral rights, ore, metals, metallic clay, oil, gas or hydrocarbon substances in, on or under said property, if any, including underground storage rights, and also including the use of such water from springs, creeks, lakes or wells to be drilled or dug upon the premises as may be necessary or convenient for such exploration or mining operations, as well as the conducting of operations related to underground storage and production of gaseous substances on the property, are specifically excepted, reserved and retained for the benefit of Columbia County, Oregon, together with the right of ingress and egress thereto for the purpose of exercising the rights hereby excepted, reserved and retained.
