WHEREAS, Ms. Aguirre has signed a Hold Harmless Agreement indemnifying the County for any injury to person or property arising from his activities during their stay at Camp Wilkerson; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Aguirre provided a Certificate Binder for Special Event Liability Insurance through Markel American Insurance Company listing Columbia County as a Hosting Facility Insured;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Katherine Aguirre is granted permission to serve alcoholic beverages during her wedding between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m. on July 2, 2011. Alcohol shall only be served by an OLCC Service permit holder and Ms. Aguirre and/or her designee shall monitor the guests to ensure no excessive alcohol consumption takes place.
