ORDER NO. 66 - 2011

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Transit Administrator has determined that the following items of County-owned property consisting of unused vehicles are no longer needed for use by Columbia County and should be disposed of:

- a) 1994 Ford with non-running engine, VIN # 1FDJE37H8RHA18985, scrap metal value of \$250;
- b) 1999 Dodge Econoline van with bad transmission and no handicap access, VIN #2B6KB31Z7XK553971, scrap metal value of \$250; and
- c) 1999 Ford with non-running engine, VIN # 1FDXE40S6XHC26382, scrap metal value of \$250.

WHEREAS, vehicles with a current market value of less than \$250 can be sold, disposed of or donated to another public agency or any sheltered workshop, work activity center or group care home which operates under contract or agreement with, or grant from any state agency and which is certified to receive federal surplus property; or any recognized non-profit activity which is certified to receive federal surplus property; and

WHEREAS, vehicles with a current market value of \$250 or more may be donated or sold to a recognized private non-profit social or health service activity; and

WHEREAS, when vehicles which are deemed to have a current market value of less than \$1,000 are not donated or sold to a recognized private non-profit social or health service activity, but are to be sold to the general public, the County may establish a selling price, schedule and advertise a sale date pursuant to Ordinance No. 88-3, Section 11.E, and OAR 125-350-015(2) (February, 1985);


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:


- (1) That the three vehicles identified above are not needed for other public purposes and are therefore declared surplus to the County's needs .
- (2) That the disposal, donation or sale of the personal property is in the public interest.


(3) That the Columbia County Transit Administrator is authorized to dispose of the vehicles in the most efficient and cost-effective method in accordance with the criteria set forth above.
