WHEREAS, the Oregon Legislature established legislation in 2011 under SB766 to designate 5-15 regionally significant industrial sites and create a process for concurrent processing and permitting in 120 days; and

WHEREAS, the Economic Recovery Review Council (ERRC) is accepting nominations for Regionally Significant Industrial Areas; and

WHEREAS, Columbia-Pacific Economic Development District, a federally designated economic development district serving Columbia and Clatsop Counties, has drafted a proposal to establish the Columbia River West Industrial Corridor (CRWIC) from Scappoose to Tongue Point as a Regionally Significant Industrial Area (RSIA); and

WHEREAS, Columbia County has reviewed and considered this proposal and concurs that the CRWIC includes regionally significant industrial areas that meet the requirements of SB 766; and

WHEREAS, in cooperation with the other local jurisdictions included in the CRWIC, Columbia County commits to supporting the CRWIC as a RSIA and to compliance with the requirements of SB 766;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved as follows:

The Board of County Commissioners nominates and endorses the Columbia River West Industrial Corridor for designation as a Regionally Significant Industrial Area.
