a Dog Owned by Julie Christopher) ORDER NO. 19-2012

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2012, Animal Control Officer Roger Kadell investigated a reported livestock attack by a dog on Sunny Hill Lane, a private road, in St. Helens, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, Officer Kadell interviewed Patricia Maenza, who reported the incident. Ms. Maenza stated that on or about 5 p.m. on May 15, 2012 a white and tan "Pit Bull Mastiff" attacked her horse as she was riding it on the roadway of Sunny Hill Lane. Ms. Maenza was riding with friend, Conde Pantoja at the time; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Maenza further explained that the Riggs family permitted her to ride her horses on their property, which is situated at the end of Sunny Hill Lane, and that Philip Woolstenhulme also permitted her to access Sunny Hill Lane from his property, located at 58799 Saulser Road and which borders on and includes much of Sunny Hill Lane; and

WHEREAS, according to Ms. Maenza, the dog attacked her and her horse while they were on the Sunny Hill Lane roadway and chased her onto Mr. Woolstenhulme's property, where the dog continued to attack; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Maenza reported that the dog had bitten her horse's leg causing it to bleed;

WHEREAS, Julie Christopher resides at 33620 Sunny Hill Lane, St. Helens, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, Julie Christopher is the registered owner of a dog, named Winston, which is listed as a white and tan American Bull Dog in the County's animal control records; and

WHEREAS, Officer Kadell interviewed Ms. Christopher, who stated that she recalled that Winston had chased the horse on the Sunny Hill Lane roadway but was not aware that Winston had bitten the horse; and

WHEREAS, Officer Kadell explained to Ms. Christopher that he would have to impound Winston for attacking and injuring livestock, and Ms. Christopher elected to surrender Winston to Columbia County Animal Control; and

WHEREAS, Officer Kadell then drove Winston to Ms. Maenza's property, and she

confirmed that Winston was the dog that attacked her horse; and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2012, Ms. Christopher's husband informed Animal Control that his family wished to get Winston back and rescinded their surrender; and

WHEREAS, Officer Kadell interviewed Mr. Pantoja, who had been riding with Ms. Maenza on the May 15, 2012. In addition to confirming that Ms. Maenza's horse was attacked by Winston, Mr. Pantoja also offered photos of the horse's injuries, which were taken immediately after the incident; and

WHEREAS, Officer Kadell interviewed Philip Woolstenhulme, who confirmed that Ms. Maenza had permission to ride her horses on his property and that he had seen Winston chasing and attacking Ms. Maenza's horse from Sunny Hill Lane onto his property on May 15, 2012; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 609.156, Ms. Christopher was provided notice of the opportunity to request a hearing in a letter dated May 24, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Christopher has waived a hearing; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Christopher signed a Settlement Agreement admitting that Winston chased and injured a horse on May 15, 2012 and agreeing to certain conditions regarding the keeping of Winston; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners considered a summary of the Animal Control Officer's report on this matter, along with the recommendation of the Animal Control Officer at its meeting on May 30th, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the report of the Animal Control Officer on this matter, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, and the above recitals, the Board of County Commissioners makes the following findings and conclusions:

1. Julie Christopher resides at 33620 Sunny Hill Lane, St. Helens, Oregon. Sunny Hill Lane is a private roadway.
2. Julie Christopher is the registered owner of Winston, described as a white and tan dog of American Bull Dog descent.
3. On May 15, 2012, Winston, chased and attacked a horse being ridden by Patricia Maenza, on Sunny Hill Lane, near the Christopher residence. Winston continued to chase and attack the horse on the neighboring property owned by Philip Woolstenhume, located at 58799 Saulser Road.
4. During the attack, Winston bit the horse's rear leg, breaking the skin and injuring the

horse.

5. Julie Christopher's dog therefore chased and injured livestock in violation of ORS 609.155.
6. According to Columbia County Animal Control, Winston has no prior record of killing, wounding, injuring or chasing livestock.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Columbia County Animal Control shall release Winston to Julie Christopher, subject to the following conditions:

1. Julie Christopher shall take measures to prevent recurrence, including compliance with the conditions set forth in the Settlement Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit "B."
2. Pursuant to ORS 609.155(3)(a), Julie Christopher shall pay all costs and fees as described in the Statement of Costs, attached hereto as Exhibit "C" and incorporated herein by this reference, and all boarding fees at a rate of \$15 per day for Winston, accruing from May 19, 2012, to the date at which Ms. Christopher either retrieves Winston or surrenders him to the County.
3. Any penalties or impoundment and boarding costs and fees imposed by this Order shall be paid prior to the release of Winston, unless otherwise agreed to in writing by the County.

STAFF REPORT

Re: Dog Winston
Julie Christopher

The dog Winston has been at the shelter for over one week after being impounded for harming and chasing livestock. Winston when brought to the shelter was found to be a larger dog with lots of upper body strength. Winston was friendly with staff and was also known by members of the shelter staff, who were surprised by the complaint against him.

During Winston's stay at the shelter, he has demonstrated no aggression towards staff, visitor or other dogs at the shelter. A check of the shelter files shows no prior complaints against Winston or the Christopher's. The investigation of the horse incident did report two prior minor incidents that had not been reported by persons in the neighborhood.

Based on this, the staff's recommendation would be that Winston be allowed to return to the Christopher family with restrictions that would be designed to prevent a re-occurrence of the horse incident. That with the protections in place, we have no objection to the return of Winston to the property on Sunny Hill Lane.

RECOMMENDED MOTIONS:

1. I move to approve Order No. 19-2012, providing for the release Winston to his owner, Julie Christopher.
2. I move to approve the Settlement Agreement with Julie Christopher for the release of Winston and authorize the Chair to sign.

<p>NARRATIVE</p> <p>Summary:</p> <p>On 05/15/2012 Patricia Maenza reported her horse being attacked and injured by the dog Winston owned by Julie Christopher. The investigation found that the dog Winston had attacked and injured the horse owned by Patricia Maenza. The dog Winston was surrendered by Julie Christopher who after consideration (through her husband) requested modification in the surrender and requested that they be allowed a formal hearing regarding the attacks. Winston was impounded at the shelter where he will be maintained pending a hearing before the board of County Commissioners per ORS 609.</p>						
<p>Narrative:</p> <p>On 05/17/2012, I contacted Patricia Maenza at her home regarding a logged call showing she had reported an attack upon her and her horse on 05/15/2012. Ms. Maenza reported to me that on 05/15/2012 at around five PM, she was riding with a horse trainer friend, Conde Pantoja. That she had permission from the Rigg's family to ride her horses at their property at the end of Sunny Hill lane. That she also had permission from Philip Woolstenhulme to cross his property to get to Sunny Hill lane area.</p>						
<p>That as the two of them were nearing the Christopher property when the dog Winston, that she described as a white and tan Pit Bull Mastiff mix dog came running out into the roadway and attacked her horse. Before the dog bit her horse she observed a younger female girl in the yard and yelled at the house to get their dog. She stated that the young girl began to yell at the dog and for her father, but the dog continued to attack her horse. She said she was very concerned as the dog was not just circling around the horse but attacking head on at the horses head.</p>						
<p>Maenza reported that the dog attack continued her horse spun around and was bitten by the dog. That as she tried to flee the area on the horse the dog continued to chase her onto the property belonging to Woolstenhulme. That in the back of the Woolstenhulme home she stopped and turned the horse when the dog attack her horse a second time. She then fled with the horse to her home at which point the dog finally ran home.</p>						
<p>At her home, she found that her horses right rear leg had been bitten and was bleeding. Conde' Pantoja wife took photos of the injury to the horse for her while she work to care for the horse leg. She then showed me the photos of the horses injuries. Ms. Maenza reported that she was also aware of other incidents involving this same dog and feared that if the dog remained that it would continue to be dangerous for her to ride her horses in the area.</p>						
<p>I asked Ms. Maenza about the care being provided for the horse. She stated that she was treating the horse herself, but that she may need to obtain follow up care or medications from the veterinarians office to complete the horses treatments. That at this point it did not appear that their was any permanent damage done to the horse.</p>						
<p>A check of animal control records for the area showed that a dog Winston, listed as a white and tan American Bull dog resided at 33620 Sunny Hill lane Saint Helens Oregon. The registered owner of the dog</p>

CASE NUMBER	was Julie Christopher. I contacted Julie at the address listed. She told me that yes she was aware of the incident from a couple days ago, but that she did not know that the horse had been actually bitten by her dog Winston.				
	Mrs. Christopher told me that the dog Winston had been in the front yard with her daughter and the rest of the family was outside doing other things. That Winston ran into the gravel roadway area at the horses, but that when her husband started his 4 wheeler the dog came running back.				
	I then explained to Mrs. Christopher that based on the complaint that Winston had attacked and injured livestock that under ORS 609.155 that he would need to be impounded. I explained to her the process in which can take place once a dog is impounded and the potential ramifications under 609. I explained to her that she had the option to surrender the dog Winston to Animal Control for placement and avoid the potential cost involved in a board hearing. She told me that she just wanted it done before the kids came home. She then told me that she was willing to surrender Winston and invited me into the home.				
	At this point I returned to my truck to fill out the surrender card. I returned to her front door and she signed the card surrendering ownership of Winston to the County. I advised her that she would be sent an invoice in the amount of \$85.00 to cover the fees for the surrendering of a dog. I then asked her if she would bring Winston to the truck.				
	Mrs. Christopher then entered the home and returned to my truck with the dog Winston. I found Winston to be a large, American Bull dog white with tan face and spots. The physical appearance of Winston would match one given as a Pit Bull Mastiff dog. Winston was friendly and showed no signs of any aggression to me as I loaded him into my truck. I then left with Winston to return to the shelter, on the way I stopped at the Maenza property and she confirmed that the dog I had was the dog that attacked her and her horse.				
	The dog Winston was then taken to the shelter and logged in as an owner surrender dog. Staff was advised of the issues with the dog and the process for locating a suitable placement was begun. The shelter staff and myself began to receive calls regarding Winston from the owners as well as neighbors. Some were offering support for Winston as being a people friendly dog. The Christopher family was asking what could be done to get Winston back, they were explained the process that was needed. They also began to raise questions about the roadway being a private road and if Winston would then not be at fault for the attack. I placed the disposition of Winston on hold while the family considered their options.				
	On Saturday May 19th, Mr. Chirstopher came into the shelter several times. He had legal questions about my authority to remove the dog from the property, on the status of the roadway being private and on the disposition of the dog. I advised him if he wished he could request that I rescind the owner surrender of the dog and proceed with the process through the board of commissioners. On a return visit, Mr. Christopher made a request that we change the dogs status as he would like to find a way to get the dog returned to them. I then changed the dogs status in our operations system.				
	As follow up, I contacted the witness Conde Pantoja, he stated that he was riding with Patricia Maenza on 05/15/2012 around 5 pm. That as they were riding down the gravel road when the dog came out. That they tried to yell at the girl to get the dog when the dog charged at them. That the dog went after Pat's horse head on towards the horse nose. Pats horse at some point spun around and the dog started biting at the horses legs and bit one of the leg. That Pat's horse then ran up the roadway and into the yards with the dog continuing to attack the horse.

Pantoja stated that when they got back to the house they examined Pat's horses rear leg where it had been bitten. That his wife took photos of the injuries as they were treating the wounds. That the horse had fresh blood down the leg.

I also contacted the property owner in which the horse ran, Philip Woolstenhulme. Philip stated that he had witnessed part of the incident, but did not see the time the dog actually bite the horse. He advised me that Mrs. Maenza has permission to use his property to get to Sunnyhill lane so that she does not have to ride on Saulser road. That a major portion of Sunny Hill lane runs on his property. That on the 15th, he did see the dog Winston chasing Ms. Maenza on her horse from Sunny Hill road onto his property attacking at the horse. That at the time the horse had run to the back grass area of his property and off the roadway area. That the dog finally ran back to his home.

Mr. Woolstenhulme added that this was not the first issue with the dog Winston. That 2 to 3 months ago his son in law had been working a bird dog in his field area. Winston had come onto the property and attacked the bird dog. That his brother who has a house also on the property, had been knocked down by the dog coming at him in his own yard.

In response to the issues raised about the roadway being a private drive, I spoke with Lonnie Welter at the road department. He advised and provided me with a plot map of the area showing Sunny Hill lane as a private drive. He also advised that there are many other issues that could not be answer here on the legal access of the roadway and easement. I noted that the roadway is listed on County maps as Sunny Hill lane with a major portion of the roadway upon Mr. Woolstenhulme property. I will include plot maps as part of the file in this case.

In conclusion on this issue, I found that Ms. Maenza had permission from persons owning or having use of this roadway to ride her horses. The dog continued his attack beyond the roadway and onto the property of Mr. Woolstenhulme. The statue do not raise the issue of where a dog attacked livestock only that it attacked and injured livestock. Prior cases before the Board of Commissioners included one in which a calf enter the back yard of a property and was killed by two dogs chained in the yard.

Case referred to the County Commissioners as the Dog Control Board.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This Settlement Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into by and between Columbia County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, and Julie Christopher.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Julie Christopher is the registered owner of the dog, "Winston," described as a white and tan American Bull Dog; and

WHEREAS, evidence shows that on May 15, 2012, Winston chased and attacked a horse being ridden by Patricia Maenza on Sunny Hill Lane and continued to chase and attack the horse on property owned by Philip Woolstenhulme; and

WHEREAS, Winston was impounded at the Columbia County Animal Shelter pursuant to ORS 609.155 for harming and chasing livestock; and

WHEREAS, Julie Christopher filed a Complaint with the Columbia County Circuit Court and sought provisional process under ORCP 83D and 85A (Case No. 12-2346); and

WHEREAS, Columbia County Animal Control also initiated a proceeding before the Columbia County Board of Commissioners to determine whether Winston's actions constitute a violation of ORS 609.155 and to determine costs and fees; and

WHEREAS, Julie Christopher has elected to waive her right to a hearing on the violation and has agreed to dismiss Case No. 12-2346 and enter into this Settlement Agreement with Columbia County for the release of Winston and disposition of the violation.

AGREEMENT

In consideration of the mutual promises set forth below, the parties hereby agree as follows:

Julie Christopher hereby admits that her dog, Winston, chased and harmed livestock, and agrees to the following:

1. Winston will be contained within the interior of the home, within a fence of at least six feet in height, or in an enclosed kennel.
2. When Winston is not contained with the home, fenced area or kennel, he will be secured on a leash and under the direct handling of a person who is physically capable of maintaining control of Winston.
3. When being transported in a vehicle, Winston will be secured on a leash or in a crate to prevent escape from the vehicle.

4. Winston will be microchipped by Columbia County Animal Control and will be registered with the Oregon Department of Agriculture.
5. In the event Winston escapes, Animal Control will be contacted immediately at the non-emergency dispatch number, (503) 397-1521.
6. The County will be immediately notified if Winston is sold, transferred or rehomed.
7. Any acts of aggression by Winston toward any person or livestock will be reported to Animal Control within 24 hours.
8. Failure to comply with any of the above terms will constitute a violation of ORS 609.095 (maintaining a dog as a public nuisance) and will subject Winston to impoundment.

Julie Christopher further agrees to release and hold harmless Columbia County, its officers, agents and employees from any and all claims, suits or actions of any nature, including claims of injury to any person or persons or of damage to property arising out of the County's impoundment of Winston and enforcement of ORS 609.155.

Julie Christopher further agrees to dismiss her claims against Columbia County under Columbia County Circuit Court Case No. 12-2346).

Columbia County hereby agrees to release Winston to Julie Christopher upon payment of all penalties, fees and costs determined by Columbia County Order No. 19-2012, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.
