WHEREAS, Earthbind Stabilizer Rejuvenating Asphalt (EBS-RA) is an environmentally friendly asphalt emulsion product for use in cold-mix road paving. EBS-RA is a proprietary product that is only available through Envi-Road; and	
WHEREAS, because EBS-RA can be used with recycled asphalt, the Road Department estimates that roads paved with EBS-RA will cost the County approximately 60% less than paving with traditional hot-mix asphalt concrete (HMAC); and	
WHEREAS, in an effort to reduce costs, the County would like to contract with Envi-Road for the purchase EBS-RA.

1. The Board finds that Envi-Road is the only contractor that can provide a cold-mix asphalt emulsion that allows for use of recycled asphalt and adopts the above recitals in support of its finding; and
