WHEREAS, on March 27, 2014, Animal Control Officer Roger Kadell arrived at 53131 Flint Drive, Scappoose, in Columbia County, Oregon, in response to a call from resident Lori Shober, who reported that she had observed her neighbor's two dogs chasing and harming her chickens; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Shober reported to Officer Kadell that she observed the two dogs chasing one of her 13 chickens out of her chicken coop; that one dog chased the chicken into a shop building while the other dog chased chickens toward the barn area; and that the dogs were "chomping" at the chickens as they ran after them; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Shober was able to secure both dogs in the shop building; and

WHEREAS, Officer Kadell identified the dogs as Bella (Mastiff) and Kodiak (Husky mix), both registered to David Hellberg at 53180 Flint Drive, Scappoose, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, Officer Kadell then proceeded with the dogs to Mr. Hellberg's address, where he encountered Mr. Hellberg's mother-in-law, Launa Eyestone, who was caring for the dogs while Mr. Hellberg was out of town; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Eyestone reported that the dogs pushed the side of the kennel and escaped and that her husband was fixing the kennel to contain the dogs; and

WHEREAS, based on the information obtained during his investigation, Officer Kadell determined that the dogs were subject to impoundment under ORS 609.155 for harming and chasing livestock; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 609.156, Mr. Hellberg was provided notice of the opportunity to request a hearing in a letter dated April 3, 2014; and

WHEREAS, on April 9, 2014, the County received a request for a hearing from Mr. Hellberg's attorney Nicholas Heydenrych, and a hearing was set for April 16, 2014; and

WHEREAS, prior to the hearing on April 16, 2014, Mr. Heydenrych filed with the Board of County Commissioners (Board) a memorandum of law arguing legal points; and

WHEREAS, when Mr. Hellberg's case came before the Board on April 16, 2014, the Board continued the matter to April 23, 2014, and gave the County until April 21, 2014 to respond to Mr. Heydenrych's legal memorandum;

WHEREAS, on April 18, 2014, Mr. Hellberg waived his right to a hearing, and on April 19,

2014, he voluntarily surrendered his dogs, Bella and Kodiak, to the Columbia Humane Society and paid impound and boarding fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, based on Animal Control Officer's report, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, and the above recitals, the Board of County Commissioners makes the following findings and conclusions:

- 1. David Hellberg, who resides at 53180 Flint Drive, Scappoose, Oregon, is the owner of Bella, brindle-colored Mastiff, and Kodiak, a Husky mix.
- 2. On March 27, 2014, Bella and Kodiak chased and harmed chickens on Lori Shober's property at 53131 Flint Drive, Scappoose, Oregon, in violation of ORS 609.155.
- 3. According to Columbia County Animal Control, Bella and Kodiak have no prior record of killing, wounding, injuring or chasing livestock.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Columbia County Animal Control shall release Bella and Kodiak to the Columbia Humane Society, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Pursuant to ORS 609.162(1)(b), a civil penalty of \$250.00 per dog is imposed on David Hellberg for the livestock attack carried out by Bella and Kodiak.
- 2. Pursuant to ORS 609.155(3)(a), in addition to the civil penalty imposed, above, David Hellberg shall pay all costs and fees arising from the impoundment of the dog, as described in the Invoice, attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein by this reference, and all boarding fees at a rate of \$15 per day for Bella and Kodiak, accruing from March 27, 2014.




