WHEREAS, on April 15, 2015, Animal Control Officer Roger Kadell arrived at 34050 Lawrence Road, Deer Island, in Columbia County, Oregon, in response to a call from resident Ervin Seufert, who reported that dogs had entered his sheep enclosure and had attacked his sheep; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Seufert described the dogs as a black Labrador mix, which he shot, and a Husky mix; and

WHEREAS, Officer Kadell observed a considerable amount of wool torn from the back of one of Seufert's sheep, which Seufert confirmed was caused by the dogs. Officer Kadell saw no other damage to livestock; and

WHEREAS, Officer Kadell found the black dog (referred to as "Leala,,), injured and hiding on the Seufert property and recognized it as one belonging to Nawnie Hack who resides at 33727 Canaan Road. Officer Kadell then drove to the Hack residence, where observed a Husky dog (referred to as "Pup,,) matching Mr. Seufert's description running loose on the Hack property. Both dogs are unlicensed; and

WHEREAS, in 2014, the Columbia County Board of Commissioners imposed a civil penalty on Nawnie Hack under ORS 609.162 for the livestock attack carried out by her dog Bo; and

WHEREAS, based on the information obtained during his investigation, Officer Kadell impounded Leala and Pup under ORS 609.155 for harming and chasing livestock; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 609.156, Nawnie Hack was provided notice of the opportunity to request a hearing on the impoundment of her dogs in a letter dated April 16, 2015. Ms. Hack did not request a hearing; and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2015, Ms. Hack surrendered her dogs Leala and Pup to Columbia County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the report of the Animal Control Officer on this matter, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, and the above recitals, the Board of County Commissioners makes the following findings and conclusions:

1. Prior to surrendering the dogs, Nawnie Hack, who resides at 33727 Canaan Road, Deer Island, Oregon, was the owner of Leala, a black Labrador mix, and Pup, a Husky mix.

- 2. In 2014, Nawnie Hack's dog Bo attacked and harmed livestock. Through Order No. 55-2014, the Board imposed a civil penalty under ORS 609.162 and assessed costs for Bo's impoundment. To date, Nawnie Hack has paid neither the penalties nor costs imposed by that order.
- 3. On April 15, 2015, both Leala and Pup were impounded for chasing and harming livestock. Ms. Hack was provided notice and an opportunity to request a hearing. She did not request a hearing. ORS 609.156(2) provides that a dog owner who does not request a hearing will be conclusively presumed to have admitted the matter alleged, and the County may take immediate action to impose remedial measures, civil penalties or other sanctions. By not requesting a hearing, Ms. Hack has admitted the matters alleged that her dogs Leala and Pup Leala and Pup chased sheep in violation of ORS 609.155 on Ervin Seufert's property at 34050 Lawrence Road, Deer Island, Oregon.
- 4. According to Columbia County Animal Control, neither Leala nor Pup has a prior record of killing, wounding, injuring or chasing livestock. In addition, no livestock were seriously injured in this incident. Nawnie Hack has voluntarily surrendered Leala and Pup to Columbia County and has therefore taken measures to prevent the dogs from future livestock attacks. ORS 609.162(1)(a) provides that a the County may impose a civil penalty of up to \$500 on the owner of a dog that chases livestock. The Board finds that because Ms. Hack surrendered her dogs taking steps to prevent recurrence a reduced penalty of \$100 per dog is warranted. However, because Ms. Hack has recently been found responsible for a livestock attack by a different dog and thus exhibits a disregard for the laws protecting livestock, the Board finds that an enhanced penalty of \$250 for habitual violators pursuant to ORS 609.163 is also warranted.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, as follows:

- 1. The following civil penalties are imposed on Nawnie Hack:
 - a. Pursuant to ORS 609.162(1)(a), a \$100.00 penalty for the livestock attack carried out by dog Leala.
 - b. Pursuant to ORS 609.162(1)(a), a \$100.00 penalty for the livestock attack carried out by dog Pup.
 - c. Pursuant to ORS 609.163(1), an enhanced civil penalty of \$250.00 for habitual violators.
- 3. Pursuant to ORS 609.155(3)(a), in addition to the civil penalties imposed, above, Nawnie Hack shall pay all costs and fees arising out of the impoundment of Leala and Pup, as described in the Statement of Costs, attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein by this reference.
- 4. Any penalties or impoundment and boarding costs and fees imposed by this Order

shall be paid within 30 days of the date of this Order unless other arrangements are agreed to in writing by County.

COMPLIANCE ORDER

ISSUED TO: Nawnie Hack

This Compliance Order is being issued by the Columbia County Board of Commissioners as requested by the County Dog Control Officer.

The Board has determined that you have violated or are in the process of violating the following County Code rules and regulations: Ordinance 92-15 as it relates to the enforcement of ORS 609. State dog regulations; In that the dog Bo did chase and cause harm to livestock.

In addition to the conditions described in the Boards determination order, in allowing the dog Bo to be returned to the owner, Nawnie Hack the additional requirements are ordered:

You must take the following corrective actions:

Redemption and payment of Boarding fees to the Columbia Humane Society in the amount of \$510 must be completed within ten days and prior to the release of the dog Bo.

The dog Bo when running free within the home must be kept under adult supervision to prevent accidental escape by minor children at the residence.

The dog Bo when outside of the confines of the home must be maintained by an adult person while harnessed to a leash unless within a secured six foot fenced area.

The dog Bo may be secured outside the home within a six foot kennel that is constructed with a no climb material or is fully enclosed with a top. The kennel will need to be secured with a pad lock to prevent accidental escape by minor children at the residence.

The dog Bo may be secured within a fenced yard if the fencing is constructed of a no climb material and the location has secured gates.

The owners of Bo will be required to report to Ccom at 503-397-1521 any escapes by Bo within 15 minutes of the escape regardless if Bo is located and returned to the property.

The owners of Bo will be required to have Bo micro chipped within ten days and a copy of the chip information provided to the county for registration with the Department of Ag.

The owners of Bo will be required to notify the county of the relocation or adoption of Bo to any other person or location than the Canaan road address of 33727.

Failure to comply with this Compliance Order shall be a violation of the Columbia County Enforcement Ordinance 92-15 section 31, for each day that you fail to comply. Citations may be issued daily for both your failure to comply with the Compliance Order and the underlying violations.


