In the Matter of the Livestock Attack by)
Dogs Owned by Kristin McGlothen) ORDER NO. 47-2018

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2018, Kimberly Earlywine called the County to report that two dogs on her property at 22123 Cedar Grove Road, Clatskanie, Oregon, were circling her chicken coop; and

WHEREAS, according to Ms. Earlywine, the smaller dog (Sitka) went to one side of the fenced chicken coop and chased the chicken into the wood portion of the coop, then the larger dog (Jasper) grabbed the chicken out of the coop and killed the chicken. Both dogs ran around her property and chewed on the deceased chicken; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Earlywine also reported that the dogs then ran to her neighbor Jill Abbott's property at 22173 Cedar Grove Road, Clatskanie, Oregon. She reported that by the time she arrived at Ms. Abbott's property the dogs were attacking the neighbor's goat. Ms. Earlywine indicated that one of the dogs had the goat by the leg and the other had the goat by the scrotum. She reported that she witnessed the larger dog (Jasper) tear off the goat's scrotum; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Abbott later made a report to Animal Control Officer Roger Kadell, on October 1, 2018, indicating that she also witnessed the smaller dog (Sitka) with the goat by the leg and larger dog (Jasper) tear off the goat's scrotum; and

WHEREAS, both women reported that Ms. Abbott hit the larger dog (Jasper) with a gun, which made the dog release the goat; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Abbott reported and Ms. Earlywine confirmed that Ms. Abbott stood between her goat and the larger dog as he circled the goat; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Earlywine reported that Ms. Abbott stood between the goat and both dogs as they circled the goat; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Collin Brehm arrived at Ms. Abbott's property about two hours after her 911 call about the incident and was able to secure both dogs; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Brehm identified the smaller dog as Sitka and the larger dog as Jasper; and returned the dogs to their owner Kristin McGlothen; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Brehm photographed the deceased chicken and injured goat. These photographs are included in Animal Control Officer's report on this matter, attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2018, Ms. Abbott emailed Officer Kadell her statement, photographs and a video showing injuries to her goat sustained from the attack; and

ORDER NO. 47-2018

WHEREAS, Officer Kadell checked Animal Control Records and identified the dogs as Sitka and Jasper, Huskies registered to Kristin McGlothen, located at 22435 Cedar Grove Road, Clatskanie Oregon. Ms. McGlothen confirmed that she owned the dogs; and

WHEREAS, based on the information obtained during Officer Kadell's investigation, he impounded the dogs under ORS 609.155 for harming and chasing livestock; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 609.156, Ms. McGlothen was provided notice of the opportunity to request a hearing in a letter dated October 8, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Ms. McGlothen requested a hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners held a hearing on October 24, 2018 and considered the evidence presented.

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the evidence presented, including the Animal Control Officer's report on this matter, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, and the above recitals, the Board of County Commissioners makes the following findings and conclusions:

1. Kristin McGlothen, who resides at 22435 Cedar Grove Road, Clatskanie, Oregon, is the owner of Sitka and Jasper, black and white Huskies.
2. On September 30, 2018, Sitka chased Kimberly Earlywine's chicken and ran around with the deceased chicken on her property at 22123 Cedar Grove Road, Clatskanie, Oregon.
3. On September 30, 2018, Jasper attacked and killed Kimberly Earlywine's chicken on her property. Jasper removed the chicken from its coop, killed the chicken, and ran around the yard with the deceased chicken.
4. On September 30, 2018, Sitka and Jasper chased and attacked Jill Abbott's goat on her property at 22173 Cedar Grove Road, Clatskanie, Oregon. Due to the seriousness of the injuries to the goat sustained from the attack, Ms. Abbott elected to euthanize the goat.
5. According to Columbia County Animal Control, Sitka and Jasper have no prior record of killing, wounding, injuring or chasing livestock.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, as follows:


1. Pursuant to ORS 609.162(1)(b), Kristin McGlothen shall pay a civil penalty of \$500.00 for the incidences of Sitka chasing livestock owned by Kimberley Earlywine and injuring livestock owned by Jill Abbott.


2. Pursuant to ORS 609.162(1)(a), Kristin McGlothen shall take reasonable measures, to prevent Sitka from chasing livestock in the future, including but not limited to the conditions set forth below:
 - A. Provide and maintain a six-foot fence that is inspected and approved by Columbia County Animal Control to prevent Sitka from escaping.
 - B. Microchip Sitka to confirm ownership information in case of escape.
 - C. No additional dogs at the property for the life of Sitka.
 - D. Owner to report escapes to Columbia County at 503-397-1521 within ten minutes of escape.
 - E. Owner commitment to immediately relocate the dog upon report of any additional harassment of livestock.
3. Pursuant to ORS 609.162(1)(c), Kristin McGlothen shall pay a civil penalty of \$500.00 for the incidences involving Jasper killing livestock owned by Kimberley Earlywine and Jill Abbott.
4. Pursuant to ORS 609.162(1)(c), within 21 days of the mailing of this order, Kristin McGlothen shall either remove Jasper to a location where, in the opinion of Columbia County, the dog will not be a threat to livestock, or surrender the dog to the County for placement in an area where the dog will not pose a threat to livestock. Otherwise, the dogs shall be deemed surrendered at the end of the 21-day period.
5. Pursuant to ORS 609.155(3)(a), in addition to the civil penalty imposed, above, Kristin McGlothen shall pay \$690.00 arising from the impoundment of Sitka and Jasper, as described in the Fee Due Notice, attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein by this reference, and all boarding fees at a rate of \$15 per day for Sitka and Jasper, accruing from October 2, 2018.

NARRATIVE (COMMENTS)							
SUMMARY: On 09/30/2018, several victims witnessed two Husky dogs, Sitka and Jasper, owned by Kristin McGlothen, in a coordinated effort attack that led to the death of a chicken belonging to the Earlywine family and causing major injury that lead to the death of a goat, belonging to the Abbott family.							
NARRATIVE:							
On 09/30/2018 at around 7:30 Am, Kimberly Earlywine reported that her cat came charging back into the house. She was concerned and went outside to find two husky dogs in her yard circling her chicken coop. These two dogs were later identified as belonging to Kristin McGlothen. At the time Ms. Earlywine stated she did not know who owned the dogs, but she was able to get close enough to read the dogs tags numbers.							
Ms. Earlywine called the county number on the tag and was on hold with County staff when the dogs attacked her pet chicken and pulled it from the coop. Ms. Earlywine said that the smaller dog went to one side of the fenced coop and chased the chicken into the wood portion of the coop. The larger dog then pulled the coop door open and grabbed the chicken and pulled it out. The two dogs ran around the yard with the dead chicken and one covered the other while it chewed on the dead bird.							
Ms. Earlywine stated that the two dogs ran off and she heard screaming coming from her close neighbors the

Abbott's. When she arrived the two dogs were attacking the neighbor's goat. One dog had the goat by the leg and the second had the goat by its scrotum. The smaller of the two ran off when the neighbor ran up to it. The larger dog held on and tore the scrotum from the goat. Her neighbor Jill was hitting the dog with her rifle as she had no bullets in the gun.

Ms. Earlywine said it was like something from a wildlife show. The two dogs continued to circle the prey goat and Jill had to stay between them and the goat. They were able to secure the smaller of the two dogs inside a pen while they waited for police response.

Deputy Collin Brehm responded to the call and did not arrive until 10:18, two hours after the attack. Deputy Brehm reported that the smaller Husky identified as Sitka was contained in the pen at Abbott residence. The second Husky was running around the area and would not come to him. He then loaded the smaller dog into his patrol car and began to head to the owners location. The larger dog, Jasper, seeing him leave ran down the road after his car and jumped inside when he opened the door.

Deputy Brehm reported that he took both dogs home to the owner Kristin McGlothen and advised her that animal control would contact her on Monday.

Deputy Brehm took photos of the deceased chicken and injured goat and forwarded the information to me via email. He reported that due to the nature of the injuries the goat was put down. See attached emails.

On 10/01/2018, I made contact with Ms. Earlywine and took her statement on the events from 09/30/2018. I also attempted contact with the victim, Jill Abbott and the dog owner Kristin McGlothen, at their homes but found no one home. I left my business card requesting contact.

A check of Animal Control Records found two Husky dogs both registered to Kristin McGlothen at 22435 Cedar Grove Road, Clatskaine Oregon. This information matched that as had been given by Deputy Brehm as the dog's owner.

I was later able to contact Jill Abbott by email. I had her send the attached email statement including photos of the events.

Sunday morning: I was on the phone with husband and heard barking. I looked outside and saw two dogs attacking my goat. I ran towards them. The one dog (smaller one) had a hold of the goat's front leg and the larger dog had a hold of my goats nuts sack. When the small dog saw me he ran off. I also contacted the dog owner, Kristin McGlothen by phone. She advised me that she was the owner of the dogs and had left the gate open on Sunday. I discussed with her the issued involved with a livestock attack and that the two dogs would need impounded until the Board of Commissioners had a chance to review the complaint. She advised me that she had been reading up on the law on this issue since the events.

Ms. McGlothen agreed to bring the two dogs to the shelter in Saint Helens for impound on 10/02/2018. We then made arrangements to meet and for any special care needs for the two dogs. On 10/02/2018, Ms. McGlothen arrived at the shelter with the two dogs and their special food and bedding. Both dogs were placed in a kennel and Ms. McGlothen was issued an impound notice.

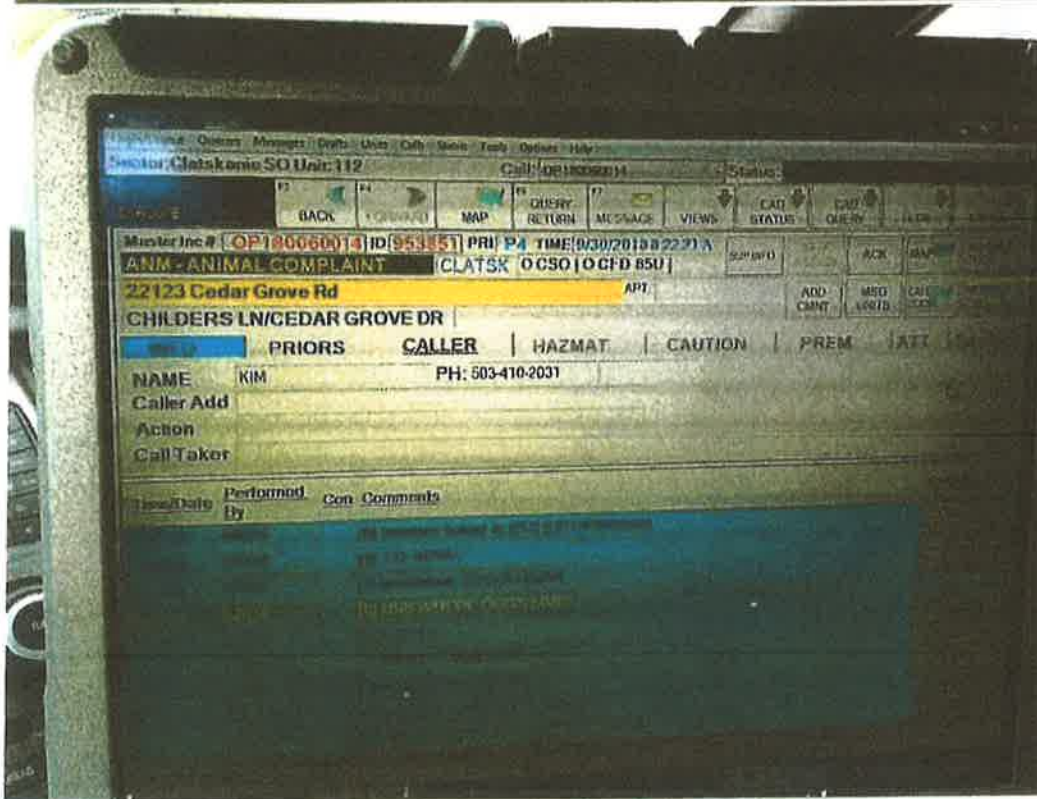
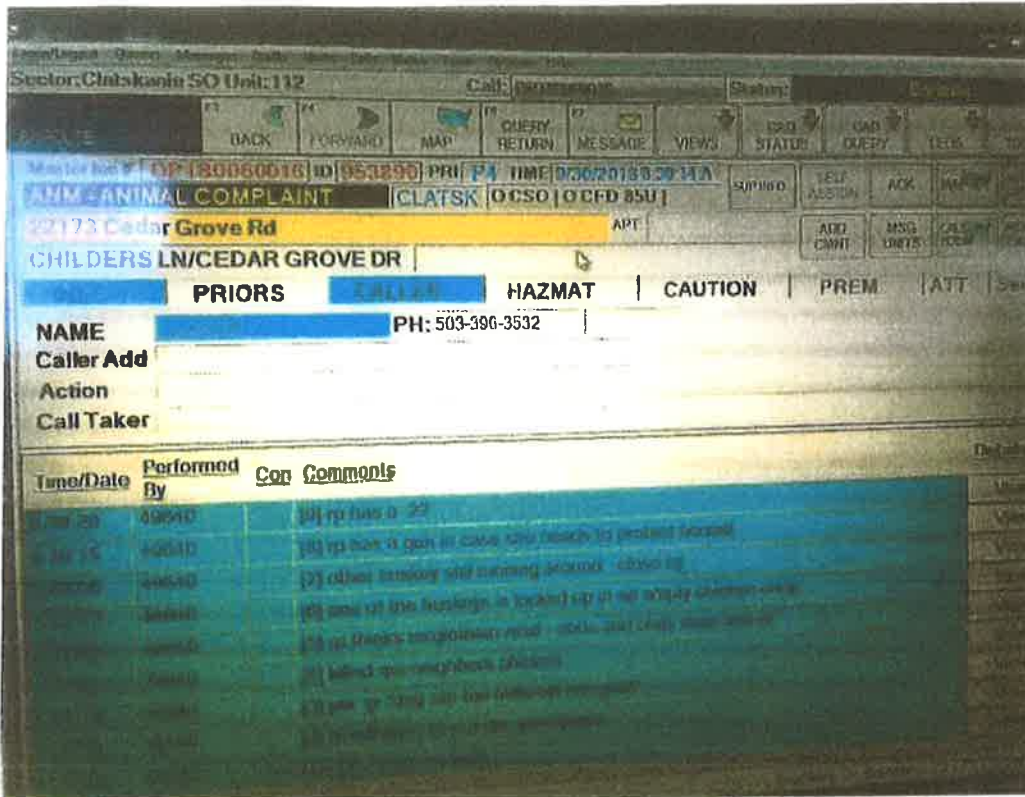

You will receive notice of an opportunity to request a hearing under ORS 609.156 and information on the hearing process from the County Attorney. Pending the outcome of the hearing the dog at issue will remain in the custody and care of the Columbia County Animal Control.

The penalty and fees for actions of a dogs found to having harmed and chased livestock can be considerable. Serious consideration regarding the hearing process should be considered. Failure to request a hearing within the notification process will result in the finding that the owner is conclusively presumed to have admitted the matter alleged and the county may take action under ORS 609.162 and 609.163.

In this case you may have also been issued a citation for violation of ORS 609.095 dog as a public nuisance, ORS 609.100 unlicensed dog, and /or ORS 609.060 dog running at large. These violation will be separate issue directed to the Justice Court and independent of the harming or chasing livestock issues before the County Board of Commissioner.
