BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR COLUMBIA COUNTY, OREGON

In the Matter of Prohibiting the Parking of Vehicles Along Certain Public or County Roads in Columbia County

ORDER NO. 69-2019

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 89-4, the Board of County Commissioners may by order or resolution prohibit the stopping, standing and/or parking of vehicles on and along certain public and county roads in Columbia County, Oregon; and

WHEREAS, under Order No. 48-2019, parking is prohibited along Laurel Beach Road, J.D. Brown Road (also known as Reeder Road) on Sauvie Island, and the east side of Dike Road near Scappoose; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that parking along Johnson's Landing Road and the west side of Dike Road, near Scappoose, in Columbia County, Oregon, should also be prohibited because the shoulder width is insufficient to allow vehicles to be parked without creating a safety hazard for vehicles traveling on the roadway; and

WHEREAS, new regulations are therefore needed to prohibit parking along Johnson Landing Road, near Scappoose;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS hereby orders, as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are adopted as findings in support of this decision; and
- 2. Parking is prohibited on and along the roads or portions of roads described in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference; and
- 3. The Columbia County Public Works Director shall place or erect traffic control devices giving notice of such prohibition in conformance with the state manual and specifications established under ORS 810.200.
- 4. Order No. 48-2019 is repealed in its entirety.
