In the Matter of Designating the Columbia County Sheriff and the Director of the Department of Community Justice as the Supervisory Authority

Order No. 83-2019

WHEREAS, ORS 144.087 defines "supervisory authority" as the state or local corrections agency or official designated in each county by that County's board of county commissioners or county court to operate corrections supervision services, custodial facilities or both; and

WHEREAS, duties to operate supervision services and custodial facilities are split between the Columbia County Sheriff and the Director of the Department of Community Justice and it is appropriate to grant supervisory authority to both in the best interest of the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered as follows:

- The Board of Commissioners designates the Columbia County Sheriff as the supervisory authority over the Columbia County Jail and Jail inmates. Unless otherwise provided by law, all persons sentenced to terms of imprisonment or incarceration of 12 months or less shall be committed to the legal and physical custody of the Sheriff and shall serve their sentence at the direction of the Sheriff, including imposition of custodial programs other than incarceration, including but not limited to work release, furlough and other alternative programming.
- The Board of Commissioners designates the Columbia County Director of Community Justice as the supervisory authority over all corrections supervision services not otherwise granted to the Columbia County Sheriff.
