Transportation District)

WHEREAS, in accordance with the procedures in ORS 451.435 and ORS 198.705 to 198.955, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Order No. 60-2019 on July 10, 2019, to approve the formation of a new service district for public transit in Columbia County, to be called the Columbia County Rider Transit Service District (hereinafter, the "District"); and

WHEREAS, through Order No. 62-2019, the Board then ordered the question of the formation of the District and a permanent rate limit to fund the District to be placed on the ballot for the November 5, 2019, special election. The question was assigned Measure 5-277 on the November ballot; and

WHEREAS, Measure 5-277 was rejected by a vote of 63%; and


WHEREAS, in accordance with ORS 198.820, the Board must dismiss its order to form the District because a majority of the votes cast opposed the formation of the District;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD HEREBY ORDERS that Order No. 60-2019, "In the Matter of Approving the Formation of the Columbia County Rider Transit Service District," is hereby dismissed and withdrawn because a majority of the votes cast at the November 5, 2019, special election opposed the formation of the District.
