In the Matter of a Livestock Attack by Dogs
Owned by Donald Denham

ORDER NO. 11-2021

WHEREAS, Columbia County Animal Control Deputy Roger Kadell's investigation report, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference, provides relevant facts in this matter; and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2021, Deputy Kadell received a call from Cheryl Knight, who reported that three husky dogs owned by her neighbor, Donald Denham, were attacking another neighbor's livestock and she fired a shot to scare the dogs away from her property; and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2021, Deputy Kadell received a call from Shannon Garcia, who reported that her daughter, Alayna Cary, chased the three dogs away from her property, located at 16130 River Front Rd, Clatskanie, OR 97016, and two of her pigs were injured by the dogs; and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2021, Shannon Garcia sent Deputy Kadell photographs of the pigs' injuries and stated she was concerned for the safety of her livestock because the dogs were loose on Donald Denham's pasture and appeared to be watching her property. Copies of these photographs are included in Deputy Kadell's investigation report on this matter, attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, on March 5, 2021, Deputy Kadell interviewed Shannon Garcia, Alayna Cary, Cheryl Knight and Donald Denham separately; and

WHEREAS, during the interview with Shannon Garcia, Deputy Kadell observed that two of Shannon Garcia's pigs were injured; one of the pigs had several bite marks down its back, a large chunk of flesh removed, missing a tail and several bite marks near the tail area; and

WHEREAS, Alayna Cary provided Deputy Kadell a diagram and a written statement about the incident, which stated that she watched the dogs run from her mother's property to Donald Denham's property as he yelled out for the dogs to come home and as the dogs ran home they would stopped and look back at her mother's property; and

WHEREAS; Deputy Kadell found that all three of the dogs attacked the pigs; and

WHEREAS, Cheryl Knight reported to Deputy Kadell that she observed three or four dogs going towards Shannon Garcia's property; she then began hearing geese making a warning noise and pigs squealing; and heard Alayna Cary yelling at the dogs to leave; and

WHEREAS; Donald Denham reported to Deputy Kadell that when the incident occurred he was inside of his house and noticed on his property camera that something was happening with his dogs in the field; he called out for the dogs, and he then went into the field to retrieve the dogs; and

WHEREAS; Donald Denham informed Deputy Kadell that three of his dogs, named Brownie, Mocha and Cookie, husky mixed breed, were involved in the incident; and

WHEREAS; Deputy Kadell found that all three dogs attacked and injured the pigs; and

WHEREAS, based on the information obtained during Deputy Kadell's investigation, he impounded the dogs under ORS 609.155 for chasing and harming livestock; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2021, pursuant to ORS 609. 156, the County mailed Donald Denham notice of an opportunity to request a hearing on this matter; and

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2021, Donald Denham provided the County with a written request for a hearing on this matter; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2021, the County mailed Donald Denham notice that a hearing was scheduled on this matter; and

WHEREAS, on March 31, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners held a hearing and considered the testimony and evidence presented; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Kadell recommended that the Board of County Commissioners impose a civil penalty under ORS 609.162(1)(b) in the amount of \$500.00 per dog and payment of impoundment and boarding fees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners considered Deputy Kadell's investigation report on this matter, along with his recommendation;

NOW, THEREFORE, based on the evidence presented, including Deputy Kadell's investigation report on this matter, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and the above recitals, the Board of County Commissioners makes the following findings and conclusions:


1. Donald Denham is the owner of dogs named Brownie, Cookie, and Mocha, husky mixed breed.
2. On March 4, 2021, Brownie, Cookie, and Mocha chased and injured two pigs, belonging to Shannon Garcia, at 16130 River Front Rd, Clatskanie, OR 97016.
3. According to Deputy Kadell, Brownie, Cookie, and Mocha have no prior record of killing, wounding, injuring or chasing livestock under ORS 609.162(2). There is no evidence in the record for this matter to find that Brownie, Cookie, and Mocha previously killed, wounded, injured or chased livestock. Therefore, the Board of


8. Donald Denham shall make a payment of at least 25 % of the total civil penalties, impoundment and boarding fees imposed by this Order prior to the release of Brownie, Cookie and Mocha, unless otherwise agreed to in writing by the County. Donald Denham shall pay the remaining balance in equal payments within six months of retrieving the dogs.

		On 03/04/2021, at around 4 pm, three Husky mix dogs escaped from the Denham property on Point Adams road in Clatskanie. The three dogs then proceeded to the Garcia property located at 16130 River Front Road, in Clatskanie where they were witnessed attacking as a pack two of the Garcia's Pigs. Both pigs received injuries, one having a chunk of skin and flesh removed. On 03/08/2021, the three dogs involved were seized and are being held

ACTION TAKEN:						
CASE NUMBER	<p>On 03/04/2021, Ccom received a call from a Cheryl Knight reporting that her neighbor, Don Denham's Husky dogs were loose and attacking another neighbors livestock animals. She reported in the call, that she had fired a shot to scare the dogs away from her property. I spoke with Ms. Knight on the phone at the time of her call. She advised me that the owner Mr. Denham was out in the field recovering the dogs and that the owner of the pigs was not home.</p> <p>During this same time period I received a message from the pigs owner, Shannon Garcia. She advised me she was at work and that her daughter had chased the dogs away. She told me that two of her pigs had been injured. She advised me that she was going to take off work in Portland and head for home. Due to it being the end of my shift, I made arrangements to meet with her in the following Am.</p> <p>Later in the evening, I received Facebook message from the victim, Ms Garcia. She sent me photos of the injuries to the two pigs and expressed her concerns that she has many farm animals and the dogs are out in the owners pasture and appear to be watching her place. I advised her I would come in the morning to take the complaint and work to see what could be done in this case.</p> <p>On 03/05/2021, I made contacted with the victim, Shannon Garcia at her home. The contact was video taped. She took me to the barn where we check the two injured pigs. One had several bite marks down the back and a large chunk of flesh removed. The tail area had also been attached and the tail was missing with several bite marks around the anal area. The damage to the animals indicated that several dog had attacked at the same time and were packing up to take the animal down.</p> <p>Alaya Cary the daughter of the pig owners was home at the time of the attack. She provided me with a diagram and a written statement on what had happened. In her statement you can see clearly that the dogs had packed up on the pig and were in the process of killing the animal when she ran out and chased them away.</p> <p>Ms. Cary statement showed that two of the dogs had attacked the more seriously injured pig and had the pig down in the ditch. The third was up by the barn area attempting to get into the goat and chicken area. All three dogs were considered involved in this attack. Ms Cary said she watched the dogs run back home as the owner was out yelling for them. She said that the however would stop and look back at her and the pigs.</p> <p>I then drove to the reporting witness Cheryl Knight home at 78473 Point Adams road. She is the neighbor to the dog owner Don Denham and has had livestock attack issues with the same group of dogs in 2019. Ms. Knight told me that she had just arrived home when she saw a third pig in her back pasture area. That the pig had walked over near the fence line with the neighbors dogs. She said that the dogs were all getting worked up and repeatedly hit the fence line. This third pig had been owner by a person down the River front Road area and had escaped. The owner had been unable to load the pig to return it home.</p> <p>Ms. Knight said that she grabbed her gun and ran out into the field as the dogs were seen repeatedly hitting the fence line. By the time she got to the area of the pig one of the dogs had jumped the fence and two more were coming over. She said she yelled at Mr Denham who had run out into the pasture that she had her gun and if the dogs came towards her she would shoot the dog. She then chased the pig into her barn to protect it from the dogs. At some point during this she fired one shot to scare them away.</p> <p>Within a few minutes she saw three to four dogs going through the grass area towards the Garcia's property. She said she then began to hear the geese making a warning noise and then the pigs squealing, clearly being what she thought was killed. She also heard the daughter of the neighbors out yelling at the dogs.</p> <p>Ms. Knight said that the neighbor got the dogs back and over the far field fence. She called Ms. Garcia at her work and told her what was going on and that the pigs were being attacked by Denham's dogs. Ms. Garcia told her she was heading home.</p> <p>Ms. Knight expressed concerns over the 9-10 Husky (wolf)dogs at the Denham property. She is concerned that the animals can not be kept fenced. We discussed her prior case in 2019 where the dogs attacked her animals as well. I</p>

advised her of the procedure that was going to be followed in this case.

I then made contact with Mr. Denham at his driveway. I gave him my card and advised him that I was recording the contact. I asked him about what had happened. He told me that he was inside the home and saw on his camera's that something was going on with his dogs in the field. That he ran out and began calling the dogs. He had a confrontation with Ms Knight, but went to the field and quickly got the dogs back inside.

Mr. Denham said that he could not see where the three dogs had gone, but that he heard that they had attacked one of the neighbors pigs. Mr. Denham confirmed that three dogs involved were, 1st Browni had jumped the fence. Then Cookie and then Mocha. The rest of the dogs he was able to keep on his side. He expressed that the pig running the fence line aggravated the dogs into jumping the fence.

Mr. Denham expressed frustration over the neighbor next door allowing her horses to knock down his fence. That he has several sections fenced, cameras and electric fencing to keep the dogs inside.

I advised Mr Denham of the fact that this was going to be proceeded as a livestock case before the County Commissioners. That I most likely would most be returning on Monday to impound the three dogs and to hold them until the hearing date. I advised him that at that time he would receive paper work explaining the hearing process.

On Monday march 8th, I returned to the location with animal care specialist Keeanna Stansbury. With the help of the owner and lots of work the animals were loaded into my truck and transported to the County Shelter. Mr. Denham was provided copies of the impound paper work and advised that he would receive a packet from the County Attorney. That he could then request a hearing in the matter. He was advised that the incident may have enhanced penalties due to his prior issue with livestock animals.

Case pending filing complaint with the County Board of Commissioner.

ANIMAL CONTROL FILE HISTORY:

Mr. Denham's dogs were all found to possess current rabies and dogs licenses.

Mr. Denham was found to having been issued a citation and was convicted on two counts of violation of ORS 609.095 Public nuisance in 2019. That case involved a livestock attack/kill but which of Ms. Denham 9 dogs were involved was not known and the only witness to the events was Mr. Denham the dog owner. In that case, Mr. Denham was convicted of public nuisance and paid restitution for one goat, one turkey and four chickens all that had been killed by the two dogs during the attack.
