

IN THE MATTER OF THE EXEMPTING
OF A PROPOSED PAVING CONTRACT
FROM THE BONDING REQUIREMENTS
OF ORS 279C.380

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RESOLUTION NO. 46-2022

WHEREAS, this Board has authorize the Public Works Department to solicit bids for paving services; and

WHEREAS, ORS 279C.380 requires all successful bidders for a public improvement contract to promptly execute and deliver to the contracting agency a performance bond and a payment bond, both in an amount equal to the full contract price; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department proposes to issue the Invitation to Bid ("ITB") in a format that provides pricing for multiple future paving projects; and

WHEREAS, the value of these future contracts are not known at the present time; and

WHEREAS, all successful bidders under the ITB will be required to post the bonds required by ORS 279C.380 for each individual paving project awarded; and

WHEREAS, ORS 279C.390 allows a Local Contracting Review Board to exempt a contract from the bonding requirements of ORS 279C.380.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

1. The Board of Commissioners for Columbia County acting as the Local Contract Review Board for Columbia County exempts the proposed ITB for paving from the bonding requirements of ORS 279C.380 on the condition that before commencing any individual paving project subject to that ITB, the contractor assigned that project posts a performance bond and a payment bond, both in an amount equal to the contractors charge for performing that project.
