Columbia Health Services

ORDER NO. 22-2026

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 96-8 authorizes the Board of Commissioners to allocate County funds to private non-profit corporations upon the Board finding that such funds will be used to promote a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, a public purpose is any activity encouraged by the County which has the objective of enhancing the public health, safety, morals, general welfare, security, prosperity, and contentment of all the inhabitants or residents within the County; and

WHEREAS, Columbia Health Services provides health services to the community and is having a Community Baby Shower event to provide expectant parents with safety gear and other necessities for their babies; and

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Public Health Department has proposed to donate \$1000 to Columbia Health Services as a sponsor of the event; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that a donation to Columbia Health Services enhances the safety, general welfare, prosperity, and contentment of the residents of Columbia County by protecting promoting the health and well-being of newborns in the community;

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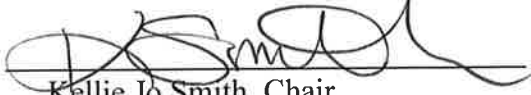
NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS HEREBY ORDERS:

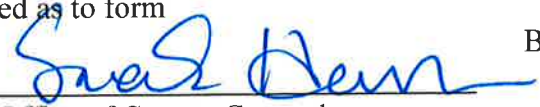

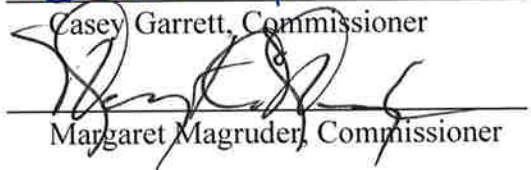
