RESOLUTION NO. 31-2026

WHEREAS, The Columbia County Sheriff's Office needs to replace its supply of body worn cameras and related accessories (the "Equipment") at a cost of \$202,556.56; and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has determined it in the County's best interest to spread the cost of the equipment over its expected lifespan; and

WHEREAS, Since 2022, the County has had a satisfactory financial relationship with Lease Servicing Center, Inc. dba NCL Government Capital ("NCL"); and

WHEREAS, Leasing the Equipment requires that the County enter a new Contract with NCL that includes an Exhibit A addressing the purchase of the Equipment; and

WHEREAS, Board of County Commissioners finds that it is in the best interest of the County to lease the Equipment under the Governmental Obligation Contract; and

WHEREAS, under the Lease Agreement Columbia County is the Obligor and Lease Servicing Center, Inc. DBA NCL Government Capital is the Obligee,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of Lessee as Follows:

1. **Determination of Need.** The Governing Body of Lessee has determined that a true and very real need exists for the acquisition of the Equipment described on Exhibit A of the Governmental Obligation Contract dated as of September 11, 2026, between Columbia County (Obligor) and Lease Servicing Center, Inc. dba NCL Government Capital (Obligee).
2. **Approval and Authorization.** The Governing Body of Obligor has determined that the Contract, substantially in the form presented to this meeting, is in the best interests of the Obligor for the acquisition of such Equipment, and the Governing Body hereby approves the entering into of the Contract by the Obligor and hereby designates and authorizes the following person(s) to execute and deliver the Contract on Obligor's behalf

with such changes thereto as such person(s) deem(s) appropriate, and any related documents, including any Escrow Agreement, necessary to the consummation of the transaction contemplated by the Contract.

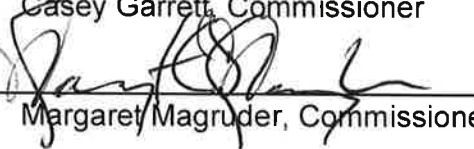
