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**ORDER NO. 27-2000**

WHEREAS, Section 11 of the Columbia County Enforcement Ordinance, Ordinance No. 92-15, allows the Board of Commissioners to authorize individuals holding certain positions to enforce certain statutes, rules, ordinances, orders and resolutions, and provisions thereof, covered by the Enforcement Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, a list of those positions upon which the Board desires to confer enforcement authority, and a reference to the statutes, rules, ordinances, orders and resolutions each respective position shall have authority to enforce, is attached hereto, labeled Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, by this Order enforcement authority shall be given to each of the positions outlined in Exhibit "A", and letters of authority shall issue to each individual currently holding such position; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the efficiency of issuing, without the necessity of further order or resolution, a new letter of authority upon a change of personnel in any position holding enforcement authority; and

WHEREAS, a list of employees currently holding the positions being given enforcement authority is attached hereto, labeled Exhibit "B", and incorporated herein by this reference;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Any employee holding a specific position within Columbia County which is listed on the attached Exhibit "A" is granted authority and jurisdiction over, and may enforce, those statutes, administrative rules, ordinances, orders and resolutions, and provisions thereof, referenced beside the title/position and labeled "Relevant Provisions" on the attached Exhibit "A", upon issuance of a Letter of Authority by the Board of County Commissioners; and
2. A Letter of Authority shall issue to each individual currently holding the specific position being given enforcement authority, as identified on the attached Exhibit "B"; and
3. A Letter of Authority may be issued by the Board of Commissioners upon a change in personnel in any position holding enforcement authority under this Order without further order or

resolution; and

4. Order No. 248-97 is hereby repealed.


