The times that I fall have caused some problems for me. I need my family to help me get around and prevent fall injuries. I have a very difficult time writing. I am disabled.

The \$150 a year for renewal is a financial hardship on me. My income is very limited. I do not object to the renewal process. I understand the need to monitor the Temporary Use Permits. I am writing to request a waiver of the Temporary Use Permit Renewal fee of \$150 (\$200 beginning 4/1/00).
