**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the annual Temporary Use Permit renewal fee of \$200 be waived as long as Ms. Marshall requires on-site assistance from family.

I am very concerned that I have to pay \$150 a year to the Columbia County Planning Department for renewal of my Temporary Use Permit to allow siting of a mobile home for a health hardship.

It is very difficult for me to care for myself. I require the assistance of my family. I try to be independent, but it is very difficult. I have fallen several times. I have a very hard time walking. The times that I fall have caused some problems for me. I need my family to help me get around and prevent fall injuries. I have a very difficult time writing. I am disabled.

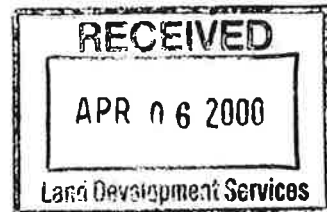
