- 1) Reserve Deputies Christopher Michael Austin and Jeffrey Brian Mansheim are granted authority and jurisdiction over, and may enforce, those statutes, administrative rules, ordinances, orders and resolutions, and provisions thereof, as referenced below, upon issuance of a Letter of Authority by the Board of County Commissioners; and
