WHEREAS, on March 29, 2000, the Board of County Commissioners approved Order No. 27-2000, In the Matter of Authorizing Certain Positions Held within Columbia County to Enforce Certain Statutes, Administrative Rules, Ordinances, Orders and Resolutions, and Provisions Thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Sheriff subsequently requested that Reserve Deputies Christopher Michael Austin and Jeffrey Brian Mansheim be given authority under the Columbia County Enforcement Ordinance, Ordinance No. 92-15, to enforce certain statutes, rule, ordinances, orders and resolutions, and provisions thereof, covered by the Enforcement Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, this Board agrees that Reserve Deputies Austin and Mansheim should be granted authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1) Reserve Deputies Christopher Michael Austin and Jeffrey Brian Mansheim are granted authority and jurisdiction over, and may enforce, those statutes, administrative rules, ordinances, orders and resolutions, and provisions thereof, as referenced below, upon issuance of a Letter of Authority by the Board of County Commissioners; and

2) The title to Exhibit A attached to Order No. 27-2000, and that section thereof pertaining to the Columbia County Sheriff, are hereby amended as follows:
