ORDER NO. 41-00

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is empowered to waive the County portion of building permit fees; and the County can waive a fee accompanying an application if the applicant so requests and it is determined that circumstances exist where it would serve the public interest and be beneficial to the County; and


WHEREAS, the Columbia County Fair Board has applied for a building permit to remodel their office space at the Fairgrounds and has submitted a request to have the building permit fee waived; and

WHEREAS, the Fairgrounds are the property of Columbia County and the Board of County Commissioners has determined that waiver of the County portion of the building permit fees for the office space at the Fairgrounds would serve the public interest and be beneficial to the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Board of County Commissioners waives the County portion of the building permit fee for the remodeling of the office space at the Fairgrounds.

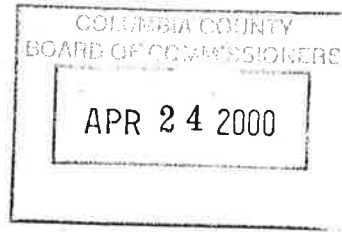
