WHEREAS, the Nehalem Valley Community Corporation has submitted a request for waiver of the County portion of the siting and septic authorization permits totaling \$341.00; and


WHEREAS, the Board is willing to waive the County portion of the fee for this non-profit community service facility.

Staff recommends approval of the waivers consistent with the public/non-profit nature of these facilities and events.

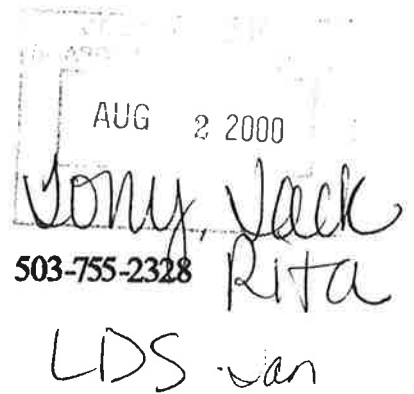

The Nehalem Valley Community Corp. is requesting the waiver of all fees related to the siting of a temporary office at the Mist – Birkenfeld RFPD Main Station.

The office will be used for promotion and fund raising leading to the construction and operation of an evacuation – emergency shelter and multi-use community building.

Nehalem Valley Community Corp. is an emerging, grass roots organization, which is responding to needs made painfully evident during and after the 1996 flood. The corporation has very limited funds.
