**Re: Ordinance to Change Solid Waste Franchise Name to
USA Waste of Oregon, Inc.**

Dear Sirs and Madams:

This letter explains our company's request to the Columbia County Board of County Commissioners to approve an ordinance to change the name of the solid waste franchise for Columbia County from Nehalem Valley Sanitary Service and Ambrose Calcagno to USA Waste of Oregon, Inc. (USAO).

Columbia County issued an ordinance in 1977 that prescribed a solid waste franchise. The franchise was amended in December 1986. Section 4.16 of the amended ordinance requires written notice of transfer of the franchise and states that the Board will act on application for transfer of a franchise within 30 days of application unless a serious question of public health or safety is involved that requires additional time for investigation and decision.

On June 24, 1998, seven-year franchises for garbage collection and recycling services in the Scappoose and Vernonia franchise areas were granted to Nehalem Valley Sanitary Service. USAO assumed ownership of Nehalem Valley Sanitary Service through an agreement for exchange of stock, effective January 1, 1999. The company's business plan is to consolidate solid waste collection under one business name. USAO's subsidiary companies are now being rolled up into USAO. One of these subsidiaries is Nehalem Valley Sanitary Service.

There will be no change in service or other provisions of the franchise. USAO will assume all obligations of the franchisee.¹
