WHEREAS, at its January 2, 2001, meeting, the Board of County Commissioners determined that *The Chronicle* is a newspaper of general circulation which is published in Columbia County and in all respects qualified to be a newspaper of record;

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The Chronicle is designated as the newspaper of record for Columbia County for the year 2001.
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners and other departments may publish legal notices in other newspapers or media in addition to the newspaper of record when it is determined that additional notice would be in the public interest.
