WHEREAS, Columbia County has been granted an Oregon Community
Development Block (CDBG) Grant, Project No. H010002, in the amount
of \$300,000 in connection with the Columbia County Regional Housing
Rehabilitation Program; and

WHEREAS, a requirement of the CDBG grant is that the County adopt and enforce policies with regard to excessive force and protecting the entrance and exit from facilities which are the subject of non-violent civil rights demonstrations; and

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Sheriff already has policies against the use of excessive force and in support of enforcing the law, but not as specific as may be required by the grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:

It is the policy of Columbia County that:

- Its law enforcement personnel shall not use excessive force against any individuals engaged in nonviolent civil rights demonstrations; and
- 2. Applicable state and local laws that prohibit physically barring entrance to or exit from a facility or location which is the subject of such nonviolent civil rights demonstrations within its jurisdiction shall be enforced.
