WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 368.341(1) the Board of Commissioners for Columbia County, Oregon (hereinafter referred to as the Board) may initiate proceedings to vacate property under ORS 368.326 to 368.366; and

WHEREAS, Richard Otis is the owner of Parcels 1, 2 and 3, Partition Plat 2000-34, from which Chase Road was dedicated. Mr. Otis has filed a petition to vacate a portion of the platted but unimproved cul-de-sac at the end of Chase Road, said cul-de-sac lying entirely within Parcel 3, in the Warren – St. Helens, Oregon, area. The vacated portion, if approved, would decrease the size of the cul-de-sac, allowing the installation of a septic system on Parcel 3.

WHEREAS, a copy of such petition is attached hereto, labeled Exhibit A, and is incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the petition submitted by Richard Otis complies with the petition requirements of ORS 368.341(3); and

WHEREAS, the area proposed to be vacated is generally described as a portion of the northwest section of the cul-de-sac at the end of Chase Road, which lies within the property commonly described as Tax Account No. 4107-040-00102, is more particularly described as shown in the attachment labeled Exhibit B, which is incorporated herein by this reference; and,

WHEREAS, a map of that portion of the cul-de-sac at the end of Chase Road proposed to be vacated and a map of the general vicinity are attached as Exhibits C and D, respectively, and are incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 368.351(2), the proceedings for vacation were initiated by a petition that contains the acknowledged signature of the owner of 100 percent of any private property proposed to be vacated and the acknowledged signature of the owner of 50 percent of property abutting the public property proposed to be vacated and the petition indicates such owner's approval of the proposed vacation; and

WHEREAS, because the petition meets the signature requirements of ORS 368.351(2), the Board may make a determination about the vacation without holding a hearing if the county road official, i.e., the Public Works Director, files with the Board, a written report that contains an assessment that the vacation is in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Board hereby initiates proceedings to vacate that portion of the cul-de-sac at the end of

Chase Road as described and depicted on Exhibits B and C hereto.

2. The Public Works Director is directed to prepare and file with the Board of County Commissioners a written report which contains an assessment of whether the proposed vacation is in the public interest.

Chose Road was dedicated to the county as requirement for the completion of the August 5, 2000, respected october 28,2000 and perexorded FAMURAY 31, 2000. As a requirement for partitioning the property, the sew parcels that would be created heeded to be evaluated by the sanitarion ad be approved for a system. Test holes here excavated and parcel 3 of the partition was approved for a standard septic system. The paved road was completed to the specifications required by the road department to complete the partition prior to recording the plat. February, A potential buyer was completing his due diligence for the purchase of parcel 3 of the plat when it was discovered by the sanitarian that the test hole for purcel 3 was excavated on whatis now the unimproved portion of the cul-de-sac at the end of Chase Rd. Additional test holes where evaluated at other locations ou parcel 3, however no other location would support a standard septie system. The vacating of this property that is part of the unimproved portion of parcel 3 would enable a standard septie system to be installed for parcel 3. The aree to the proposed vacation was determined by a neeting and review from the road department prior to this application. Had it been brought to our attention earlier, we would have requested these changes to the configuration of chase Rd. prior


