WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 368.341(1) the Board of Commissioners for Columbia County, Oregon (hereinafter referred to as the "Board") may initiate proceedings to vacate property under ORS 368.326 to 368.366; and

WHEREAS, Michael T. and Virginia Taylor own property abutting a portion of Bonneville Drive lying within the plat of Columbia Acres No. 1 near Scappoose, Oregon, which is proposed to be vacated, and have filed with the Board a petition requesting that the Board vacate said portion of Bonneville Drive; and

WHEREAS, a copy of such petition is attached hereto, labeled Attachment 1, and is incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the petition submitted by Mr. and Mrs. Taylor complies with the petition requirements of ORS 368.341(3); and

WHEREAS, the intersection of Bonneville Drive and Highway 30 was recently reconfigured, and that portion of Bonneville Drive proposed for vacation is no longer being used as a public right-of-way and the petitioners desire to put this property to better use; and

WHEREAS, that portion of Bonneville Road proposed to be vacated is generally described as lying between properties commonly described as Tax Account No. 3224-024-04000 and Tax Account No. 3224-024-05100, and is more particularly described in Exhibit A to Attachment 1 hereto; and

WHEREAS, a map of that portion of Bonneville Drive proposed to be vacated is attached hereto as Attachment 2 and is incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 368.351(2), the proceedings for vacation were initiated by a petition that contains the acknowledged signatures of owners of 100 percent of any private property proposed to be vacated and acknowledged signatures of owners of 100 percent of property abutting the public property proposed to be vacated and the petition indicates such owners' approval of the proposed vacation; and

WHEREAS, because the petition meets the signature requirements of ORS 368.351(2), the Board may make a determination about the vacation without holding a hearing if the county road official, i.e., the Public Works Director, files with the Board a written report that contains an assessment that the vacation is in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The Board hereby initiates proceedings to vacate that portion of Bonneville Drive lying between properties commonly described as Tax Account No. 3224-024-04000 and Tax Account No. 3224-024-05100, which is more particularly described in Exhibit A to Attachment 1.
- 2. The Public Works Director is directed to prepare and file with the Board of County Commissioners a written report which contains an assessment of whether the proposed vacation is in the public interest.


